Chatelaine's Report: We were very happy to have several newcomers at Versus of the Stone. We still need men's loaner garb for the Baronial Gold Key.

Chancellor of Minors Report

Versus of the Stone had fun children's activities. There were 5 children participating.

Chirurgion's Report: Anyone wishing to become a Chirurgion should contact Lady Elizabeth (Shrewlet) for assistance. Fighters should be mindful of fighting outdoors with the colder temperatures.

Canton Reports:

Charlesbury Crossing: A&S is on pause for three more weeks. All their reports are in on time. They are still working on an archery site, waiting on issues to be resolved. They will be hosting the lunch at Winter University.

Baelfire Dunn: Drums of War is coming soon. See our flyer in this edition for more info. Accepts should be up soon so you can register on line. If you would like to make sure you get a spot for Murienne's fantastic feast, feel free to go ahead and mail a check to the event registrar.

Aire Falcon: We are still meeting. We had more members at the last meeting. We are considering possible demos for the future.

Crois Brigitte: A&S is gearing up for each Wednesday. We had 15 people at the last business meeting. Our next project is SADD.

Salisbury Glen: We are working on upcoming St. Urhos. We will be having fighter practices for both adult and youth and will be announced when they will occur.

MiddleGate: Versus of the Stone was a very successful event We had 94 people in attendance. The silent auction to raise money for the Baronial Regalia Fund raised \$518.

We are working on a demo for a school in Greensboro.

Old Business:

The Sacred Stone trim will be available soon. We have a sample that Baroness Sine will bring to the next meeting for everyone to see and further discussions will be had as to how much we need to order and how to order it.

Middlegate raised \$518 at Versus of the Stone to donate to the Baronial Regalia Fund. The first purchase will be feast gear, protective sleeves and a carrying case for high table.

Old Business: (cont.)

A lengthy discussion was allowed and encouraged on the topic of moving the baronial e-list from a yahoo group to the kingdom server. Everyone had an opportunity to ask questions and voice their opinions on the topic. Public archives would be available. The ability to add attachments would be enabled. It would eliminate the possibility of the Yahoo group being cancelled by the owner of that list. A vote was taken by the populace. It was approved with one person objecting. Reminders will be sent out of the move date and instructions on how to sign up. The baronial policy will be amended to reflect this change.

Leisure Fabrics: Lady Nuala is working on organizing a trip to Leisure Fabrics in High Point in February. The owners have agreed to open it's doors to SCA members on a Saturday other than their normally scheduled 2nd Saturday of the month, provided we have enough people who want to go. She will then talk with the owners and announce which day the trip will be.


Martial Activities: Heavy melees, rapier melees, archery and thrown weapons, siege demo and authorizations.

- *There will be French and English dancing in the castle after the feast. Check our website for a list of classes.


