## FROM THE HEAVY MARSHAL

Greetings from the Baronial Marshal,

As we come into the hotter months please ensure you heed the warnings and stay hydrated during all marshal activity. Also if you are putting on your armor or taking the field for the first time in a while please check to make sure everything is in good repair. If you have been active take the time to check it over before heading to a event. At Golden Rose I had to do some minor weapon repairs on the field for myself before the tourney and helped make sure some others folks were legal to fight. Keep your Kit up to par!

### Events

Baronial Investiture:

A heavy tournament was a 5 rd. Bedford Points. The Event report has been filed with the marshal late. As of the last I heard we were still waiting on the Light weapon report to be filed. I will check on the status of that.

A Note for any MIC's. If ALL the activity marshal's file their individual reports it is encouraged but NOT required that you file an overall event report. Just make sure that all activity reports are filed in a timely manner.

### Rules updates and reminders:

UPDATE - 2" two handed thrusting tips:

Experimentation with the ICE FALCON 2" tip has been suspended following a recent incident. The 2" Mandrake Armory tips are still good. If you are inspecting weapons and are not familiar with these items ask! If you can please check out the Mandrake Armory website to know what one looks like before inspecting at an event.

Cut and Thrust:

Please ensure that in any instance where this is being practiced or run that the Masks are of sufficient construction. I believe this means "3 weapon Legal" but differ to the input of the Rapier community on this. I am just aware that there have been incidences of damaged masks recently and we need to be sure we are using adequate gear and practicing safely.

A few reminders:

If you are a marshal please check the KEM site and make sure you are not expired.

I am available to anyone who needs Marshal classes 101 or 201 for Heavy. Please contact me if interested.
