## ARCHERY CHALLENGE !!

*As Target Archery Marshal for the Barony of Sacred Stone, I set forth a Challenge to all archers of this good barony.*

*Did the long, cold winter cause you to fondle your bow and arrows lovingly while staring out a window at the snow and ice, wishing for a thaw so you could get at the archery butts? Well NOW is the time to KICK BUTT at the BUTTS!*

*The last Baronial Archery Challenge "The Devious Davina Challenge" was won by The Honorable Lady Lorelei Greenleaf. As winner, it is her responsibility to come up with the next challenge, and she has. It is her wish that we take to the Line, and show the rest of the Known World who the finest archers are, The Archers of Sacred Stone. Swish.*

*You had a chance to warm up at SAAD, so let's move on by pulling up those Royal Round scores and getting BACK on the Kingdom Archery Scores list: <http://www.scores-sca.org/home/index.php?R=2> They've re-added the "Fun Stats" feature, so you can now track all sorts of interesting information, in addition to scores.*

*The winner of this challenge will be the one who improves their Royal Round score the most, from their current (JWA) historical average on the Kingdom database. Since it is more difficult to improve scores at the higher ranks, Lorelei will give special incentive prizes (archery bling) to those who improve most within each of the ranks. For example, someone in the Novice category may improve more than anyone, and they would win the Challenge, BUT...if you improve most within your rank of say, Bowmen, compared to other Bowmen, you get the bling! The Honorable Lord Christophe of Grey has agreed to check the RR data base and figure out the baseline. If you do not have a RR score, then shoot three royal rounds and that average will be your baseline. This challenge will run from May 15 to August 15th with the winner being announced at Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday.*

*Also set forth for Baronial Birthday, will be the Baronial Championship and the Jr. Championship and the naming of the Captain of the Baronial Archery Guard. See this link for details about these requirements. <http://sacredstone.atlantia.sca.org/Archeryelig.htm>*
