## Old Business-

Phoenix trim from Calontir- Populace voted and passed having Gisela take pre-orders for 30 days since minimum order is 1000 meters. Orders must be minimum of 10 yds. and must be paid for in advance at \$2.00 per yd. Yet to be determined who will manage inventory and orders.

- Café Press website is now up and running. We can now order items with Phoenix to display Baronial pride. Checks from Café Express will go to Exchequer.
- Baronial Land Agent needed for Pennsic

It was agreed that Lord Tom Brandt, his wife Lady Audrey and Lady Prudence would work out the details of being on site at Land Grab at Pennsic. Tom would be Land Agent but Prudence would be there for the first day of Land Grab.

## New Business-

Porta-fence -Raphael de la Rosa

Raphael presented to the group a proposal that he would build a list fence to be used primarily by the rapier community. He requested funding for the fence. The populace voted and approved the amount of \$200 to reimburse Raphael for the expense of the fence upon completion.

Lochac Permission to Conflict - Prudence

Prudence presented a request from the Barony of Lochac in Australia to use the word Yeomanry in their Awards for their barony. Populace voted to grant permission.

Buildings -Jonathan Blackbow

Jonathan presented a proposal for building a portable building on the Elchenburg property to be used for multiple purposes. The populace raised several concerns with storing items in this building or leaving it on Walter's property. The discussion was dropped for now.

Children's Fete at Pennsic - Murienne

A motion was presented and approved by the populace to allocated \$300 to the Children's Fete at Pennsic.

# Baronial Policy

## 1. The Policies

1.1. The Barony of the Sacred Stone, its Baronial Coronet, its officers, and its Populace wish to clarify and codify the procedures by which this, our Barony, operates. To this effect, we have written the following set of Baronial policies specifying the methods which we employ to govern ourselves.

1.1.1. In all cases, these Baronial policies shall be consistent with Corpora and Atlantian Law. If such conditions should arise where there may be conflict those documents shall always supersede this Charter.

This set of policies shall be amended from time to time to conform to both Corpora and Atlantian Law.

1.2. Changes to the Baronial policies.

1.2.1. The Baronial policies can be amended or altered by the Barony of the Sacred Stone at any time, provided:

1.2.1.1. All proposed changes to the Baronial policies that are made at a Baronial meeting shall be published in the Baronial Newsletter the month of the meeting in which they will be discussed and/or voted upon.

1.2.1.2. No changes shall be made or acted upon without approval at a Baronial meeting.

## 2. The Barony

2.1. For the purposes of these policies, the Barony of the Sacred Stone shall be defined by, but is not limited to, all those geographical regions specified by Corpora and Atlantian Law.

## 3. The Baronial Coronet

3.1. The Baronial Coronet shall be defined as the territorial baron and/or baroness appointed by the Crown of Atlantia.

3.2. The Baronial Coronets' term shall be in compliance with Atlantian Law.

3.3. The appointment of a new Baronial Coronet shall be conducted in accordance with Atlantian Law.

## 4. Baronial Meeting

4.1. A Baronial meeting is any assemblage of the populace which is called by the Baronial Coronet in order to receive advice on the administration and governance of the Barony or for the populace to vote on such issues as are required by policies.

4.2. The meeting agenda and the actual running of said meeting is the responsibility of the Baronial Seneschal(e).

4.3. Specifics of the Baronial meeting shall be called as follows:

4.3.1. The date, time, and place for the Baronial meeting shall be published in the Baronial Newsletter.

4.3.2. Between scheduled Baronial meetings, emergency meetings of the Baronial Financial Committee may act in the Barony's best interests. Such actions will be reported at the next regularly scheduled Baronial meeting. The Baronial Financial Committee is defined in the Baronial Financial Policy.

4.4. Voting members of Baronial meeting.

4.4.1. When a vote is required, members of the Barony are defined as paid SCA members who reside or participate within the geographical boundaries of the Barony. All votes conducted shall be simple majority.

## 5. Baronial Officers

5.1. Each Baronial officer shall report on the state of their office at each Baronial meeting. Each Baronial officer is required to attend at least one Baronial meeting per quarter, or provide a proxy and report to the Baronial Seneschal(e) and Coronet 48 hours prior to the Baronial meeting. Non-compliance with this policy will result in a recommendation for removal being forwarded to the appropriate Kingdom officer.

5.2. All papers (including official correspondence) and regalia accruing to any office are the property of that office and must be transferred in their entirety to any new Baronial officer within thirty (30) days of any change of office.

5.3. Appointment of Baronial officers.

5.3.1. The opening of a Baronial Office shall be made public by all of the following methods:

◇ Announcement at a scheduled Baronial meeting,

◇ Through written announcement in the Baronial Newsletter, and through announcement in the Baronial e-list and website.

5.3.2. Announcements shall include a deadline of no less than 14 (fourteen) days from the date the opening is announced in all required venues.

# Baronial Policy

5.3.2. Announcements shall include a deadline of no less than 14 (fourteen) days from the date the opening is announced in all required venues.

5.3.3. Interested candidates shall respond in writing to the Baronial officer, Baronial Seneschal(e), and Baronial Coronet.

5.3.4. At the deadline, the list of candidates shall be published on the Baronial e-list and website, inviting written commentary from the populace to the Baronial Seneschal(e) and the Baronial Coronet.

5.3.5. The Baronial Seneschal(e) and the Baronial Coronet will review the commentary and together select the candidate and recommend such to the Kingdom officer for warranting.

5.3.6. At such time, the warranting Kingdom officer allows, the new Baronial officer shall be publicly announced via the newsletter and website.

5.3.7. Due to the length of the event, no officer changes shall be made during the duration of the Pennsic War.

5.4. Baronial officers may select whatever deputies they require for the duration of their office.

5.5. Duties of the offices of the Barony of the Sacred Stone are given in Corpora, Kingdom Law, Baronial Financial Policy and this document. Baronial offices may consist of, but are not limited to:

- Seneschal(e) (required by corpora)
- Exchequer (required by corpora)
- Herald (required by corpora)
- Chronicler (required by corpora)
  - ◊ Additional Duties: The Baronial Chronicler shall be responsible for taking the minutes at Baronial meetings or designate an acceptable deputy and publish the minutes in the Baronial newsletter.
- Knight Marshal
- Minister of Arts and Sciences
- Minister of the Lists
- Archer Marshal
- Rapier Marshal
- Minister of Children
- Chatelaine
- Webminister
  - ◊ Additional Duties: Shall publish the Baronial Newsletter to the Baronial website no later than the 1st of each month and/or within five (5) days of receipt of the same from the
  - ◊ Baronial Chronicler.
- Chirurgeon

5.6. Baronial Officer Term Limits

5.6.1. Officer terms shall be limited to a two (2) year warrant with an option for two (2) one (1) year re-warranting if needed or desired.

5.6.1.1. Any office not required by policy to be filled at all times, shall go vacant if a suitable replacement is not found:

- ◊ At the end of the term,
- ◊ With the loss of Baronial support, or the loss of interest to continue in the office.

6. Baronial Events

6.1. The Barony or the Barony's Cantons may sponsor events in accordance with Baronial Financial Policy.

7. Waiving The Baronial Policies

7.1. Any part of these policies can be waived under special or extreme circumstances by approval of the Coronet and Baronial Seneschal(e) with a full accounting to be given at the next regularly scheduled Baronial meeting.

7.2. Any part of these policies can be waived by approval of the Barony.
