Persona Development

My first laurel in Trimaris, Giuseppe de Borgia, you may know him as the dance master of 12th Night 2013, told me that when your persona is developed you can explain what you had for breakfast, what your house looks like, what the politics of the time were, and what your village/town looks like. How many can do that? Wearing a cotton tunic with Celtish trim over jeans and Nikes just doesn't seem to cut it does it? So this article is about persona development.

The basic idea behind persona development in the SCA is to identify a period of time in which you are interested. Then develop a persona that could have but did not actually live in that period. Thus I cannot be Robin Hood even though I am known as an archer. So what is Christophe's persona by way of explanation?

Christophe of Grey was the second son of a French lord. As such all lands and owning of the lord went to the first son. Thus Christophe had no choice but to join the Crusades in which to, hopefully, make his fortunes. As it turned out he was fighting under Lord Grey's banner when Lord Grey became severely wounded. As it turned out Lord Grey wanted to return home to die and Christophe and his younger brother Kastoff escorted Lord Grey to his home lands which happen to be in modern day Wales. When there Christophe and Kastoff vied for Lady Grey's, Lord Grey's daughter, hand. Christophe being the smooth talker he is known for won her hand and became, tradition of the time, Lord of Lord Grey's lands and holdings when he soon died from his wounds from crusade. Kastoff learned after a year of living with his brother and lost love, he was better off in the lands of the Crusades.

 - Due to changes to Pennsylvania laws, minor fighters at Pennsic this year (those 16-17 year olds authorized to fight with adults on the armored and rapier fields) will be required to have their parent's cell phone number written on the already required gold diamond helm/cuff marking.  - Also, the new rules for youth armored combat that brings us up to Society standards have been added to the on-line policies. These new rules are contained within section 3.8.4.7 and all subsections. With the changes at Society level, these will now overrule section 3.8.3.6 where applicable.
