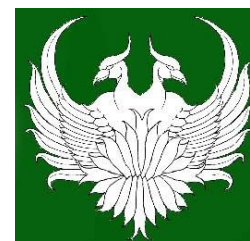

Due to the fact that, as with the real world we live in, the children participate often as much as their parents, and as the Society has expanded so has the activity level of the children born into it as well as those whose families new to our ranks. To keep up with this growth, we would like to bring to the notice of the populace that we have been asked to create/re-create two youth awards, but with a little tweaking. Up to this point, The Feather of the Phoenix has been a catch all for all children, up to about age 16/17, for anything they have done in the society. The proposal made to us is to keep the Feather the award for all areas for children up to the age of 10. It has been proposed that The Phoenix's Onyx, be re-created for Youth participating in any marshal activity (archery, equestrian, rapier and armored combat included) ages 11 to 16, and the Phoenix's Peridot be re-created for Youth participating in areas of service or the arts, ages 11 to 16. I believe that everyone can agree that from the age of 17 on, the youth of the SCA truly are considered young adults, more often than not performing the same work as those much older, so we feel they qualify for the adult level awards. We wish to bring this to your attention, and ask for commentary from everyone at both the July and August Baronial meetings.

Once again, we ask that if you come across any mugs, goblets, etc., please consider donating them to the Barony for the newcomer goblet initiative. We are finding that with so many new to the Society and the Barony, that we have been giving out a great many of them, as also with the toys for the children's box. The looks on the faces of both the newcomers and the children is certainly a site that warms the heart.

The SCA from a Different View

Attending an SCA event as a new person can be overwhelming. Attending your first war, Gulf Wars, Pennsic or even War of the Wings can be overwhelming. But the ONLY way to really get to know this hobby and if it is a good fit for you is to get INVOLVED.

Now let's talk about nobility, those folks with the big metal things on their heads, kings, queens, barons, baronesses. If you ever ask them how many XXXX (name your event of choice) they have attended, you may get an answer like "Attended or were present at?". You see, as nobility they are seldom at liberty to do the things they would like to do but have obligations representing the people their position represent, Queen's Teas, tournies, competitions, and endless commander's meetings along with order meetings, peerage meetings, etc., etc. So what's my point? Am I soliciting sympathy for our nobility? Nope, rather an opportunity for the rest of us. For nobility to do all they should do to fairly represent us they need help and that's where we fit in.

All nobility need retainers. So what does a retainer do? They are the "helper person" for nobility. Please note I did NOT say gopher or slave or flunky. As a retainer you may be asked little more than strolling about with nobility. They may get cornered by someone and need an escape so the nobility turn to you and say something like "What time was that meeting I needed to attend?" To which you may reply, "I believe they are waiting for us now". OK, kidding there, but that is part of the job of a retainer. The best part is you get to see how the SCA works from the inside.

Being a retainer is a volunteer position and typically does not last the entire event nor all day/night long. Retainer shifts are typically an hour or two at a time. This means you get to provide some service, get to see the inner workings of the SCA and still have time to do event related activities of your choice.

But getting involved is not restricted to just retainer duty. When I first joined the SCA I did a lot of water bearing for the fighters and served a lot of feasts. I enjoyed doing it and got to meet a lot of folks and had the chance to get up close and personal with a lot of them. Plus IT WAS A LOT OF FUN!

So in addition to retainer duty consider volunteering to be "on staff" for an event. This will give you a close appreciation for all that goes into making an event happen. For archery and thrown weapons it involves making the targets and butts, getting them to site, setting up the range, running the shoot/throw, taking down the range and getting all the stuff back to storage. All aspects of any event include a lot of pre-planning done well before the event. Even helping out at an event takes the load off of many who have spent a great deal of time pre-event getting all ready.

So consider volunteering some time to work on staff or retain at the next event. Find out who is autocrat, the head person for the event, and volunteer. You will get to meet some fantastic people while helping out. Speaking personally from 17 years experience, it has always been rewarding and afforded me the opportunity of meeting some pretty amazing people.

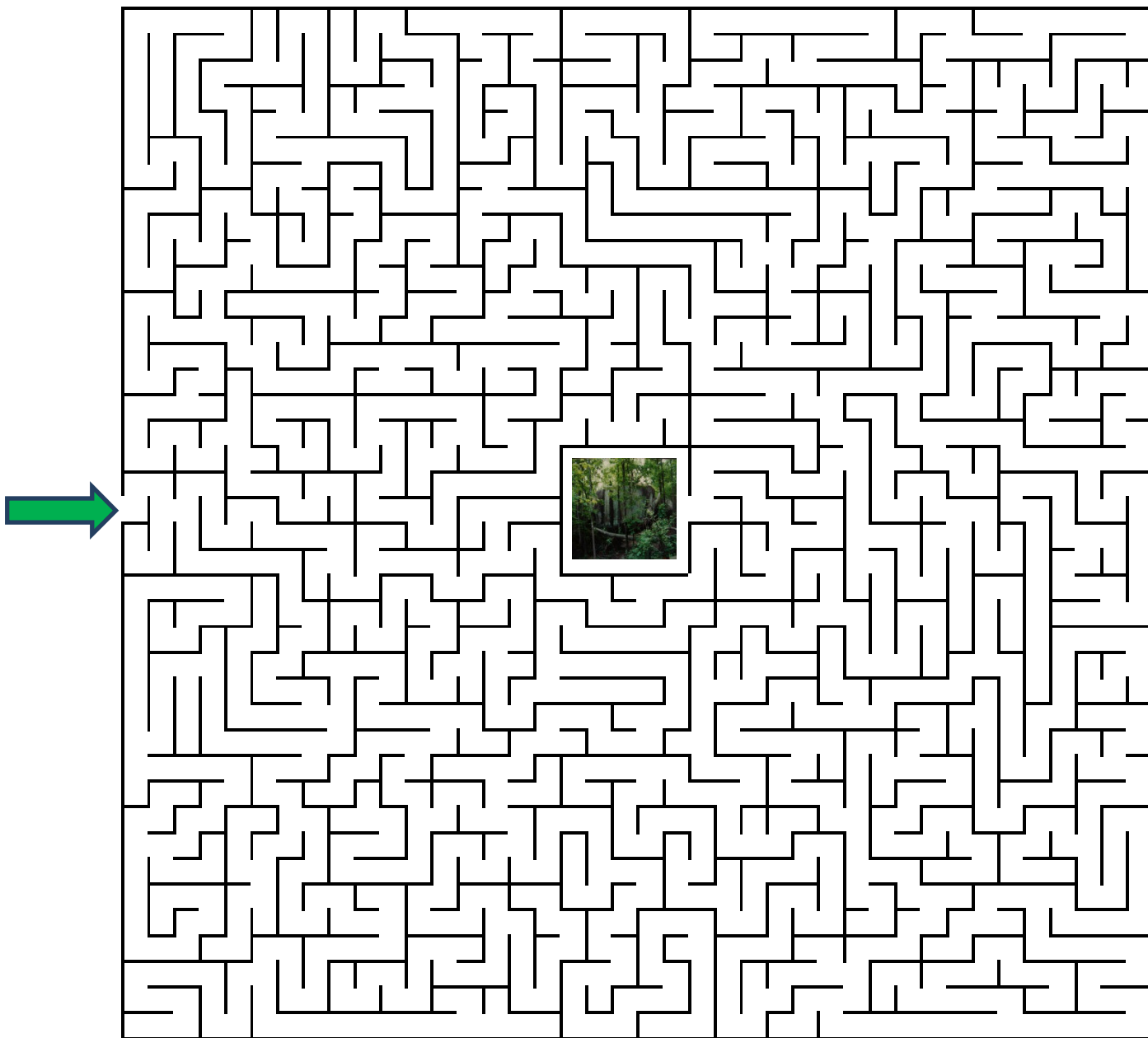

What's in a Device?

Or, a swan rousant contourny, a sinister tierce gules;

Gules, a dragonfly and a gore argent;

Sable, a drakkar under full sail and on a chief argent three crescents gules;

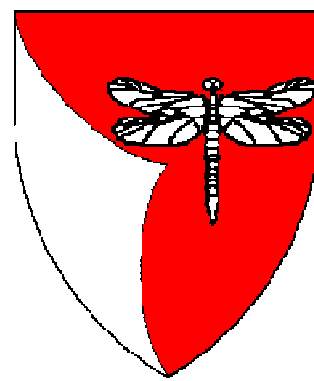
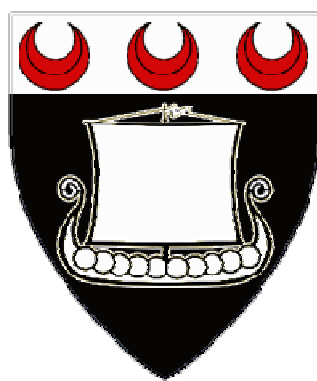
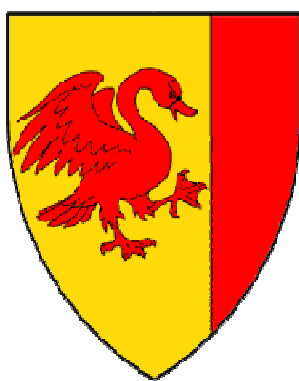
Vert, a dragon statant erect affronty, wings displayed argent, pierced through the chest with a sword sable within a bordure engrailed argent

The above blazon describes the devices carried, worn, flown, etc by Baroness Alianor, myself, Baron Talorgen, and Master Achbar. When you see these devices flying on banners, most likely we are nearby. If you see devices on stuff such as belts, tunics, gowns, bags, umbrellas, mugs, etc it most likely means that it is owned by someone who claims that device as their own. As our friend Baroness Gisela often is heard to say, "Heraldry works." Heraldry is our calling card to the world that says "I APPROACH!" or "This is mine!"

So how do we come up with (1) something that will pass and (2) something that represents us? We do a little research, a little prayer to higher powers would not be amiss, and we build our story. To some, their device may tell about their beginnings in the SCA, their journey through life, or their favorite animal, vegetable, or medieval item. Here are few stories from our Barony.

A friend of mine, Robert Shockley, has submitted his device for consideration. He has included wavy lines to represent his travels across the Atlantic ocean, roses to represent his hometown of South Hampton, and a background pattern that looks like little sparks. My device (second one above) represents my favorite colors (red and silver/white), a dragonfly which in some cultures represent change, and a gore representing the turning page of a book. Baroness Alianor shared part of her device's story at a Day in the Park last year. She pointed out the spike on the back of the foot of her swan to remind us that swans are not always the gentle creatures they appear to be.

Next time you see some cool heraldry, take the time to ask how it came into being. The answer may surprise you.

Articles of interest, cool pictures from events you attended, games, puzzles, guild news, and other submissions are welcome as we move forward with our Newsletter. Please have your submissions to me no later than midnight on 30th of the month prior to publication.

Chirurgion's Report (Lord Lady Bera in Svarti)

The decision has been made to close the Office of the Chirurgionate as of August 10th, 2015. The board and corporate officers want to extend their gratitude for ALL who have served our organization in this capacity in the past. To those who have provided feedback, questions, and worked to explore options for scopes of the office that would allow our organization to retain the office and maintain insurance coverage for the officers and our organization, many thanks as well.

To clarify some of the concerns that have been raised during the many discussions of this change, the board and corporate officers want to provide the following information:

The Society Seneschal has been directed to remove references to the Chirurgionate from the Record Retention Policy. Existing records should be retained for 2 years for adults, 21 years for minors, then shredded to ensure any Personally Identifying Information is destroyed.

Local groups should sort records into Adult, Minor and Destroy categories and ship (paid for by the local group) records to the corporate office. The corporate office will retain records and handle the shredding.

Each Kingdom has thirty business days to transport these records to the corporate office.

Event Coordinators/Stewards/Autocrats are still responsible for arranging for EMS on site if that is required by municipal/county/state requirements. This most often will apply to large events projecting an attendance greater than the threshold set by the applicable modern agency. It is recommended to include information regarding distance from site to medical care in event announcements, particularly for camping events.

Baronial Meeting (cont.);

The marshallate will still be responsible for reporting injuries on the field. Seneschals will still be responsible for reporting injuries (particularly requiring transport) as currently directed.

Tangible assets owned by SCA branches that are specific to the Office of the Chirurgion may be retained or donated or sold, in accordance with applicable financial policies.

Over the counter medications may not be purchased by SCA branches to distribute or make available to event attendees.

The badge of the fleam will remain available for those individual volunteers (not affiliated with the SCA, Inc. and its Kingdoms and local groups) willing to provide basic first aid.
