How-to: Naalbinding

Hello everyone! Winter is coming and cold weather is starting to creep up on us again. What better way to warm up in these upcoming cold and dark months than by working with yarn? I would like to introduce you to the warm wooly world of naalbinding.

The following video shows one of naalbinding's most basic stitches, the Oslo stitch: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=EcuUqeKQZ5Q

This stitch is pretty easy to pick up. Once you get the hang of it, you can make mittens, socks, cowls, and any number of warm accessories. All you need is a large eye, blunt-tipped needle and some nice thick yarn. Wool, alapaca, or any other feltable kind of yarn works best as naalbinding is done with short lengths of yarn. It is easiest to use a spit-splice to felt a new length of yarn to the old, but if you have a wool allergy or would prefer to use a non-animal fiber, you can use different joining methods. When you would do a spit-splice, you could do a Russian Join (video example here: https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=9MXT2mrR894), or you could drop the old length and repeat the previous stitch with a new length of yarn to join (you would essentially be doing the same stitch twice, once in the old yarn and again in the new yarn. This would mean a lot of ends to sew in once you finish your piece, but if you don't mind, go right ahead!


