Salesberie Glen: Fight practices continue twice a month with good attendance, both youth and adult. They have several archery MITs who are close to finishing the program and are planning on starting monthly archery practice as soon as they are warranted. The first quarterly practice at the Van Hoy site was small but also pretty cold. They had youth and adult heavy fighting.

Crois Brigte: Regular monthly archery practices this month at Robin and Aine's house in Clemmons, see Crois Brigte's website calendar for upcoming practices. Plan to start armored combat practice soon, stay tuned for more info.

Charlesbury Crossing: Holding armored combat practice in Freedom Park in Charlotte and occasionally at private homes. Master Achbar is teaching a marshaling 101 class at Summer University. They have newbies working on newbie fighting kits.

Nothing going on in the other cantons right now but will soon with nicer weather.

From the Kingdom MoL: Newly launched MOL on line authorization system based on based on the Atlantia Enterprise Login (AEL) system used for pollings and registration for University. Fighters will be able to login to the system to print their own authorization card.

Fighters, MOLs, and Marshals – If you do not have an AEL, please get one.

In order to support this migration, they need every fighter to renew their authorization on the new forms. MOLs are being authorized to take these renewals at events, meetings, fighter practices, etc. For the next year, renewals are free and new authorizations or add on weapons forms are \$1. The renewal will extend your authorization expiration to four years from the date of renewal.

After this initial year push to get every fighter renewed, fighters will have the option to renew on line at no charge. The system will send you a reminder email three months prior to your authorization expiring.

For those with platinum cards, after the initial year, the renewal will remain \$1 to receive an updated platinum card. New platinum cards are still available for a \$10 fee which goes directly to the Kingdom Travel Fund.

There is a list on the Crown Tourney website that gives the items that you may use and what the categories are for competition. The final competition is field presence. Prizes will be given to those whose field presence gives the best use of heraldry, best individual, and best group.
