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Shifting Our Perspective

About four or five years ago, then Sir Mark (now our Baron) changed my life with a single sentence: "Don't you wish every day could be like Pennsic?" Of course I instantly agreed, but that wasn't the end of my pondering about it.

A couple months later it "clicked." SCA camping is a lot of work. The weather sometimes interferes. (Gulfnado, anyone?) Yet we work feverishly to set up just so we can exhaust ourselves competing / displaying / teaching / socializing, at the end of which we have (you guessed it) more work to do. Then, (especially if you've achieved a certain age), there might be only a couple hours for relaxation/socializing before sleeping. For longer events, waking starts the cycle anew. Exhausting! And superb fun.

Wow, and this is paradise? Yes, yes it is. Each event creates stories worth telling, and we look forward to making changes, progress, for the next event. Our reward for hard work is... the joyful anticipation of more hard work, perhaps harder hard work.

So if paradise features mountains of hard work happily shoveled, then what's the problem with all the mundane work-life between events? That between-event life isn't separate. If you mentally back away from the trees to see the forest, the days/weeks between events are just times for preparation and planning. When camping at an event, all that setting up, cooking, cleaning, rearranging work is seen as part of the adventure. With that being the case, the work performed between events, even mundane work resulting in paychecks, can be seen as the same: part of the adventure. One great example of this is exhibited by a couple friends who taught me that they like to use Gulf Wars as a celebration for finishing their taxes. So, while they're swimming in that lava of filling out those forms, they naturally have visions of Gulf Wars lightening their moods: That's genius!



I admit that practicing thinking of between-event mundane life as preparation for the next event doesn't sound like much of a revelation, but therein lies the secret: Re-framing your thoughts in this way, by focusing on your lifestyle's carrots, (the joy of SCA events), you'll find that you can face all that between-events time with a bit more enthusiasm, a bit more endurance. Naturally, that translates to your getting a bit more accomplished most days. And that adds up. The results of that progress is a bit of extra self-esteem, of confidence, of enthusiasm, of endurance. And those things further brighten your perspective. Which leads to more accomplishments. Etc. It's a positive spiral, a happy cyclical syndrome.

Try it. It's free. And there's no downside. Practice keeping happy thoughts of your next event in the back of your mind, and see how that casts your day-to-day routine in a brighter light. I'd write more, but I need to get other tasks done so I can focus on preparing for my next SCA event!

Due to a power outage at our meeting location, the meeting was cancelled on Saturday, 7/9/16 at approximately 7:00am. The following are the notes submitted in advance to the meeting.

Coronet's Report (Baronne Alianor atte Redswanne):

- 1) Thanking Baroness Nuala for running the fundraiser, at University, for the purchase of awards and tokens for the Baronial populace
- 2) Thanking Lady Jdeke for the gift of Drakken Eggs and Flames she gave us at Crecy.
- 3) Asking everyone who is going to be attending Pennsic to please see me there, as I will have favors for all members of Sacred Stone
- 4) Baronial Birthday is coming quickly. Looking forward to seeing everyone there.
- 5) Please start getting reservations in for War of the Wings camping. We would like to have an awesome camp this year, but need to know the number of people we will be working with.
- 6) Asking all Chatelaines that at any event, Canton or Baronial, to please set aside a time for where Marc and I can properly welcome them to Sacred Stone. If anyone brings a new person(s) to an event, to please bring them buy to meet us, even if we are in the A&S hall or on the side of a fighting field (obviously not while we are in the middle of fighting or what may seem like an important conversation)...
- 7) Their Highnesses have challenged the Peers, and therefore we are challenging all members of Sacred Stone, Peers and non-alike, to please do all you can to make newcomers feel welcome. This also means leaving political, internal and/or personal bias' out of any and all conversations either with or around anyone new to the Society. Pay attention to your surroundings and all who may be overhearing any conversations. The biggest complaint of all new folks has been that they are being dragged into the political arena and being set to take a side before they even understand what the SCA is and find the parts that they enjoy.

Officer's Reports

Seneschal's Report (Mesternö Bessenyei Rozsa):

The proposed Baronial Policies and Baronial Financial Policies will be published in the August newsletter for vote at the September Business meeting which will be held at 10:00 a.m. the Sunday of Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday.

We received one bid for War of the Wings XII and that was from Baron Edward and Baroness Reyna. Their Excellencies and I have reviewed the bid and have accepted it. A formal budget is anticipated to be put forth to the Baronial Financial Committee for vote at the September meeting.

Note: When submitting bids for Baronial events all staff members listed must be confirmed and committed to being on staff for your event. If you submit a bid with "placeholders" as staff members it cannot be considered a viable bid and therefore cannot be accepted.

Facebook is a wonderful tool for certain things and we have become accustomed to getting answers within moments of asking a question. However, at times that answer is not readily available and people are working very hard behind the scenes to get an answer for you. Please do not think that you are being ignored. Often the simplest questions may require 4 or 5 people to come to a consensus for there to be an answer to relay, and as many of us have full time jobs and families that come first, getting that consensus may take a little bit of time. When asking questions of your officers and Baronage, please try to give them a day or two to respond and if you don't get a response, ping them privately.

Polling Orders: I have had some questions to me personally lately and have seen questions on various lists regarding polling orders and wanted to take a quick moment to explain (and possibly remind some folks) what polling orders are in the SCA. Polling Orders are set up so that a body of the populace with similar interests have an avenue to discuss others who have similar interests and bring them to the attention of the Royals in hopes of having that person recognized for their



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achievements and inducted into the Order. Most polling orders have watchlists that are set up by members of the Order that are listings of people that they especially desire other members to keep an eye on and help out from time to time. Polling Orders gather together and discuss the progress of various members on the watchlists when the Royals call for a meeting. The rest of the year they keep up with each other via their Order elists. From time to time the Royals will direct the Order Principal to conduct a polling of various members on the watchlist (and sometimes not on the watchlist) as to whether or not the Order feels those persons are ready to be inducted into that Order. The responses are private and go directly back to the Royals. The results are rarely, if ever, shared with the Order or Order Principal. The Royals will then make a decision as to whether or not to induct that person. All that is required for the induction of someone is for a polling to be conducted. After that it is completely up to the Royals' whim as to when and if someone is inducted regardless of whether the individual had a 0% positive polling or 100% positive polling.

Deputies: While I do have two amazing deputies, neither have taken the position on with the desire to become the next Baronial Seneschal. If that is something you are interested in, please contact me. While it does not guarantee that you will be the next Seneschal it does give you an advantage.

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
