July 2018 Business Meeting Minutes

Meeting was Opened.

I. Officer Reports: Baronage: June was awesome! There was the demo at the Con; the return of Sir Axl; University; Return to Crecy; and Blades and Bows. Sacred Stone members were at all of them and good times were had. They look forward to July being just as great. Her Excellency is looking forward to a rousing discussion at the policy review meeting. Their Excellencies both expressed their thanks for all the hard work they have seen from Sacred Stone members. Great job!

Seneschal: Unevent is going well and she is also looking forward to tackling the policy review. Mistress Fiona reminded everyone that Seneschal reports were due earlier in the month and Chatelain reports are due on the 15th. She also expressed excitement that there were now two deputy seneschals: Lady Elizabeth and Mistress Annora. Lady Elizabeth is working on a spreadsheet of what folks in the Barony can do, teach, are interested in, etc. If you want to be added to the list, please contact her.

Chronicler: Absent.

Chatelain: Lord Robert is stepping down in August. Mistress Fiona thanked Lord Robert for his long term service to the Barony. She requested that any gentles interested in the position send a Letter of Intent to her and their Excellencies before the August business meeting. Lord Robert announced that several groups have gotten new folks in and things seem to be going well.

Exchequer: Currently the Barony has a total of \$25,116.22 in unallocated funds. The Q2 report has been started and will be in by the due date. An example of an allocated fund was provided – the Baronial Travel fund, which currently has \$112.06 is an allocated fund. The Exchequer requested approval to pay the storage shed costs. A discussion was had on how much to pay (3 months, 6 months, longer) and it was agreed in a vote that the Barony would pay for 6 months. Lord Robert requested we discuss the Children's Fete donation and it was agreed that would be discussed after officer reports.

Herald: Their Excellencies noted how fun the Baronial Herald and his reports were. Master Iskender was unable to attend but sent a report/letter requesting that anyone who received awards at Return to Crecy should check and make sure they show up appropriately on the Atlantian Order of Precedence. He also pointed out how wonderful our local heralds were and thanked them all for being awesome. Her Excellency noted that the herald's report for Crecy was turned in before she managed to reach home on the Sunday after the event. The populace was duly impressed at the speediness of the reporting but saddened the Herald was not in attendance so teasing could commence.

Marshal: Absent but Master Achbar attended in his stead. Two marshal classes were held at Unevent by Master Achbar. It was reported that if anyone needed help from the marshal, to contact Lord Alesander or Master Achbar.

MOL: It was reported that the Barony still needs MOL's and our Baronial MOL needs a deputy. Baroness Sajah offered a MOL class on the spot and there was great rejoicing.

Quarter Master: The items borrowed for Crecy have all been returned. Mistress Annora put forth that some of the objects they bor-

rowed were not in good condition, to the great surprise of the Quarter Master. It was requested that if an item is damaged while checked out, that upon the return of the item a damage report needed to be made. Our stalwart Quarter Master requested that PRIOR to any donations being made to the Barony, folks find out what the Barony NEEDS. Too many people are using the Barony as a place to bring items when cleaning out their garages and we cannot afford to store and maintain new items that are not useful. It was mentioned that if the Barony does not need an item, folks check with their Canton or even the Kingdom, as they might have needs for it. One member requested a Baronial Wish List be made and it was agreed that would be done. One member suggested we make Baronial Loaner Armor. The suggestion was tabled to allow research to be done on policy and safety protocols in reference to this idea.

MOAS: Absent.

Youth: Our Youth Officer requested that people not abandon items they want to donate at kid's activities. There is a proper method to donate items and just leaving them at an event is not the right way. There were stern warnings that dire consequences would happen if anyone was caught trying to donate glitter to the Barony and/or Youth Activities. (The Barony will not be held responsible for an outbreak of recreation violence should glitter be donated.) Mistress Annora noted that someone lent the most amazing crocheted water balloons to Return to Crecy. She noted that they were super fun and also super easy to clean up. She agreed to post a link to the pattern for said balloons when she got home.

II. Canton Reports: Aire Faucon: There has been a seneschal change-over and an Exchequer change-over in the Canton. AF is hosting weekly AnS nights.

Charlesbury Crossing: There are regular outbreaks of recreational violence at the park on Sundays and much fun and shenanigans at the regular Monday arts and sciences nights. It was duly noted that Hildegard Beregen rocks. Many folks pointedly requested she teach her eyelet class which was rumored to be "super amazing" and great excitement was expressed for her scheduled Key Hole Neckline class to be held that day.

Crois Brigade: There are regular weekly meetings with rotating locations.

Middle Gate: A report will be sent to Chronicler for inclusion in the minutes but was summarized: Location of weekly AnS nights have been moved to the Park on Wed. nights as the previous location is closed. Lord Reginald is stepping down as Canton Herald and a replacement is needed. There are regular fighter practices and business meetings. A great big thank you was given to folks that assisted with and attended Return to Crecy. It was noted that Mistress Annora and her staff held a great event.

Salisberie Glenn: Regular weekly meetings happening at Mean Mugs. Days in the Park are scheduled through October.

III. Old Business: War of the Wings 2018: Baroness Sajah came forth and entered a growling challenge for Sir Jared the Bear. It was noted that Sir Jared was the last winner of the War of the Wings Baronial Champions Tourney and it was time to give him a fight and test his mettle. They Excellencies appreciated the challenge and announced that they would certainly be happy for a champion of their choice to meet Sir Jared on the field of battle.

Salisberie Glen Days at the Park: They reminded folks that their July Day in the Park was coming up on July 22nd. They requested folks come out for a day of relaxed socializing and fun.

Pennsic 2018: The Barony had previously approved sponsoring the Atlantian Children's Fete at Pennsic. Lord Robert expressed his concern that the funds allotted would not be enough. The memory of the populace was that we had previously approved increasing the donation to \$300.00 but our Exchequer stated she would confirm this amount.

Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday 2018: The autocrat stated she was worried about the number of port-a-potties required as there are activities now happening on site which will increase attendance. It was noted that we are required to have one toilet for every 25 persons in attendance. The barony agreed to increase the budget for toilets by \$200.00 to accommodate additional rentals in case of additional attendees. Mistress Fiona & Mistress Kisaiya noted that a class on Roman Garb was in the works to help folks prepare for the event.

12th Night 2019: Amended budget was presented at June meeting. A vote was held to approve said amended budget. The vote was 15 for, 0 against, and 7 abstaining. The amended budget was approved.

Spring Coronation 2019: The original site for the Bid has requested to be allowed to hold a Jamboree on that date. The Barony agreed to release the site and the autocrat stated she would complete a new bid, with a new site.

Gardens of Thyme 2018: The autocrat reminded everyone of this event happening in August. It was noted that pop-ups were needed for the event, as shade for classes. It is a free event with many exciting classes, competitions, and a Baronial Court!

IV. New Business: Runestone 2018: It was noted that in the Order of the Phoenix Eye Meeting Mistress Kisaiya foolhardily agreed

to turn in a bid for this event, since no bids have been received.

Queens Rapier 2018: Her Excellency noted that she was putting in a bid for this event, but not under the Barony. It will be held at Star of Bethlehem Church in Winston Salem, NC.

Fall Coronation 2018: Lady Elizabeth noted that she wanted to put a bid in for Fall Coronation 2018 (as the Kingdom has noted no bids have been received). She has located a site – Sandy Ridge Girl Scout camp and done a preliminary bid but the Kingdom timeline requires a yes or a no immediately. A vote was put forth to allow Lady Elizabeth to put in a bid with the requirement that the budget still needs to be presented to the Barony and approved by the Barony. The vote was 23 for, 0 against, and 1 abstain. Lady Elizabeth was provided with her required approval.

Baronial Meetings Schedule: Mistress Fiona requested that the Barony figure out the meeting schedule for the rest of 2017. The following was decided:

August: Will be held in Middle Gate on Sunday August 26th (Sunday after Gardens of Thyme). September: Aire Faucon offered to host September. October: Salisberie Glen will host October at their Day in the Park that month. November: Charlesbury Crossing will host November. December: Crois Brigde will host the December party.

The attending members of the Joyous Horde from Nottingham Coill invited the Barony to attend their Investiture and Baronial Birthday in January 2019 at Sandy Ridge Girl Scout Camp.

Pennsic 2018: Lady Prudence reminded folks that she was in charge of gate at Pennsic this year and would be mightily cranky if any Baronial members embarrassed her by being totally unprepared. She noted that the only people who should try and check in at land agent check in were actual land agents, as anyone who was not a land agent would not be allowed to check in. She noted that you should have your ID, membership card, photo of your license plate, etc. on hand before you get to your turn to check in. She also noted rules on bringing minor children that are not your own have changed, so people should read the rules.

The meetings was adjourned and then immediately re-opened to address on new piece of business.

Her Excellency and Mistress Aine noted that the Society MOAS had expressed interest in Sacred Stone hosting the first ever Knowne World Agricultural, Forestry, Husbandry, and Herbal Symposium. A bid and budget is being prepared for this to happen at Elchenburg on Labor Day Weekend. Mistress Gisela will be the autocrat. The Barony was requested to approve the concept of turning in the bid with the budget and details to be provided at the next meeting. A vote was held with 17 for, 0 against, and 2 abstaining. It was approved that Mistress Gisela and her team could turn in a bid.

With that, the meeting was closed and all present went to other meetings and classes.
