Letter from the Seneschal

Unity of the Barony is critical. To accomplish this goal, we would have regular meetings of all the canton Seneschals to discuss issues and concerns and to recognize those individuals who deserve recognition. We would travel to each canton business meeting at least once a quarter to meet and talk with their members. We would reinstate quarterly Curias to give everyone in the Barony the opportunity to bring forth their ideas, concerns and issues. Fostering regular, effective communication between the cantons will bring us closer together as a barony and enhance our feeling of family and unity.

Growth of the Barony and retention of Newcomers is our second goal. To accomplish this, working with canton Seneschals and Chatelaines, we would go beyond the standard Court welcome and schedule Coronet meetings at local events to meet and welcome Newcomers. Also working with Seneschals and Chatelaines, we would endeavor to receive a list of email or postal mail addresses of Newcomers who have attended events.
