NEW BUSINESS

There are three open positions coming up: exchequer, chirurgeon, and herald. If interested, please send letters to the baron, baroness, and seneschal, as well as the current holder of the position.

Event waivers: no matter what, if in charge of an event you must send waivers to the kingdom officer — and if there are none, please let them know that.

The Minister of Arts and Sciences proposed regalia to identify baronial officers at events. Depending on the choice of the officer, they could include, belt favors, baldrics, armbands...

Next year, it was suggested that a group bid be submitted for Baronial Birthday. What do we want to see? More participation from the barony is being encouraged. The bid is due January 1st.

Ragnarr and Lynette (as well as the barony) will be continuing the tradition of giving mugs to newcomers. Collection will be up to individual cantons. Elspeth will be in charge of supervising this.

The Ransom the Cure fundraiser will no longer take place one Their Majesties step down.

UPCOMING EVENTS

War of the Wings: October 9-13. Still the biggest event in the kingdom.

ACCEPS glitched, so the cut-off for pre-registration was extended. Please remember to fill out the land form! You have until September 19th to mail the check to Edmund.

We are still in need of volunteers, which even includes donating stuff for childrens' activities. (All children's activities will happen in or around the castle, including the Queen's Tea.)

There will be a Laurel vigil at WoW. Does anyone have a spare tent? Tal volunteered to bring one.

Staff will be on site Sunday to lay roads, mow, etc.

We are in the process of adding four more showers — two for the men, two for the women. These will be located out by the ravine and open only during the day.

On Thursday night, we will need baked goodies for the welcome social — please see Murienne for details.

On Friday night, the Charlotte Waites are coming for the masked ball. A motion was made to let them in for no site charge; the vote carried with two objections, no abstentions.

It was proposed to allow faculty members from UNCSA on site for four hours for a blacksmithing demo. A motion was made to reduce their site fee, on the grounds that they would be a good potential resource. Good for publicity. Nothing in the policies covers this. For the financial vote of this, there were four opposed, two abstaining. The final decision was to let them on site for \$6 apiece.

The electric fence for the cows will be moving on the 29th, so that archers will not be graced with their presence.

All of the arts and sciences activities are now listed on the website, and class registration is up!

There is an additional call for canvas — please see Caitlin if you can help. There is a need for a performing arts day shade.

In a Phoenix Eye: November 9th. ACCEPS is now open. It costs \$4 for adults. The website is currently being updated, especially with the baronial champion competitions: brewer, youth, performing arts, and cook.

Peers: please bring a prize for your entry of choice.

Judges are still needed!
