At the Fourth Atlantian Crown Tourney, held in the Canton of Falcon Cree, Viscount Sir John of Outman defeated Lord Arkein Steinschliefer von Uberstein in the finals to become the fourth Crown Prince of Atlantia.

During Court Lord Jason My-kull petitioned King Gyrth for the Shire of Emanon to become The Barony of the Sacred Stone. He, Lord Jason, presented the Shire's records of achievement to Master Robin of Mannesfeld, the Kingdom Seneschal.

King Gyrth promised that Emanon would become a Barony before his reign has ended (Nov. XVII). Anyone who is a member of the SCA and a citizen of Emanon may be nominated for any of the listed posts (see page 7). Baronial elections will most likely take place in September. Melee of the Far Mountains

The Seneschal, Knight-Marshal, fighters and all other members of the Canton of Hawkwood send warm greetings to the seneschals and people of Emanon, Windmasters Hill, Knottinghill Co:ll and to all of their friends, old and new, within the Kingdom of Atlantia.

Gentles all: we write to invite the fair ladies, valorous fighters and all other folk of the Kingdom to participate in the Melee of the Far Mountains. The weekend of May 14-16, A.S. XVII, Hawkwood shall host war practice at a beautiful mountain site. Scheduled to date: general fighter practice, individual challenge "grudge" bouts, organized training and practice in the art of Society warfare, melees and combat galore! Do not fear, this is not a gathering solely of fighters. All folk are cordially invited to partake of our hospitality. There will be ample space for all types of board games, outdoor games and anything else that can be imagined.

The site is within a half hour of Asheville and Black Mountain, NC. Deep within these mountains, surrounded by miles of forests, we guarantee safety from llamas and emus and other exotic beasts. Children and leashed pets are welcome, provided they do not fit that description. Our secluded site has a heated bath house, with hot and cold showers; a beautiful lake for swimming and canoeing (canoes available for our use--anyone for an amphibious assault??). We have cabin space for 30, plenty of room for tents and pavilions, and crash space available nearby. Our field for battle is gigantic. The area we will be using is mundanely known as Camp Little Pisgah and lies within the domain of the Canton of Hawkwood. Some of our fighters are feverishly working to finish a secret project (whoops!) to control this area.

Our Cooks and Poisoners Guild has promised a feast to rival any they have yet held. After the feasting we plan dance lessons and carousing well into the night.

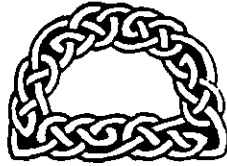
The site is discreetly wet, dinner wine only. Entertainers are very welcome and will be given a one tyger reduction in cost. Including lodging and feast (no breakfast) \$6 in advance, up to May 2, and \$8 thereafter. To cover site costs, we must charge \$3 offboard, even to those who do not stay the night.

Again, our main purpose is to give all fighters the opportunity to further advance their skills in group and individual combat. All non-fighters are encouraged to grace us by attending--we promise that they will not be bored. We ask that interested support us by attending. Is it not true that the real strength of the Society lies within us, as a group, rather than the prowess of the individual?

The new Knight Marshall for the Guardians of the Sacred Stone is Joseph of Clairridge. He was warranted by Earl Sir Strykar Gierharaldson at Crown Tourney in Falcon Cree on May 1. Joseph is authorized in weapon & shield and florentine forms. His predecesor, Lord Karl von Nord Mark, shall continue to serve the kingdom as a Marshall-at-Large.

As of September, A.S.XVII it shall become law in Atlantia that fighters utilize some form of rigid joint protection such as high-impact plastic, hardened leather, or steel. Basketball pads alone will no longer be at all acceptable. The joint protection must extend around to protect the sides of the knees & elbows.

Hindscroft



On Sunday, May 16, A.S. XVII , the North Carolina Shakespeare Festival is sponsoring a medieval fair and "Birthday of the Bard" celebration, and would welcome SCA participation. Entertainers, fighters, merchants, musicians, and anyone else are cordially invited. Everyone who comes from the SCA will receive FREE FOOD - all you can eat, folks! Also the site is DAMP - that is, beer and wine and the like can be consumed. But you have to bring your own. Be sure to bring your membership card so they'll know you're with us. The Registration fee is a paltry 2 crowns (that's \$2, mundane money); proceeds will be divided between Acorn and the Shakespeare Festival. Send to Gallegher of the Far Shore (Richard Edwards, 421 E. Hendrix St. Apt.G Greensboro, N.C. 27405). The site is Kepley's Barn, a large wooden-beamed mead-hall just outside of Greensboro, N.C. with open country around it, perfect for fighter demos. Directions: Take your best route to I-40 west, take the exit for the High Point-Greensboro Airport and turn right on to Rt. 68 South. After approximately 3 miles there will be a sign on the right for Kepley's Barn; turn right. The Shakespeare Festival needs to know how much food to prepare, so please register in advance. Thank you.
