On Sunday, September 5th, A.S. XVII, the Shire of Emanon was made the Barony of the Sacred Stone by Their Royal Majesties, King Gyrth and Queen Melisande. During Royal Court that day Lord Jason Michael of Andover and Lady Susan Douglas of Andover were invested as Their Divine Excellencies, Baron Jason and Baroness Susan, and charged with the care of the Barony of the Sacred Stone.

On the 5th, at the Royal Court of Gyrth and Melisande, Lord Jason Michael of Andover was inducted into the Order of Chivalry by being Knighted by King Gyrth. The most revered Accolade of Knighthood was passed to Lord Jason after he was found to be most Chivalrous and Courteous in all ways, and to be most proficient at arms by the Knights of the Realm.

Sir Jason is the first lord from the southern region of Atlantia to be made a Knight. And in recieving this honor has not only honored himself, but his fellow Guardians of the Sacred Stone.

During the afternoon at the Investiture a Baronial Champions Tourney was fought by the warriors from the Sacred Stone. The victor of this tourney, and first Champion of the Barony of the Sacred Stone is Harsul of Brutonholm. Harsul shall serve the Baron and the Baroness in this capacity for a period of one year, at which time a new Champion shall be chosen by right of arms. Harsul shall act as the bodyguard of the Baron and Baroness and shall march at the head of the column, with the Baron, of the Baronial Levy in time of war.



LIVE BIRD PIE by Lady Helene

Live bird pie was served at feasts in the Middle Ages. The small birds would fly out of the thin pastry crust, as a group of hawks was sent off to pounce on the smaller birds for the entertainment of the feasters.

For decoration peacock skin was often placed over the cocked carcass of an animal to be served at a feast.

A crude form of brandy, called "water of gold", was used to promote health, revive the spirits, and prolong youth. It was also believed that it assisted the cure of colic, dropsy, and paralysis.


