

Event bids for Baronial Birthday and In a Phoenix Eye deadline was extended to January 14, 2005 due to difficulty reaching Baronial Officers during the holiday season. One was submitted for SSBB by Lord John van der Velde and one was submitted for IAPE by Lord Christian de Rosado. Both bids have been accepted and we are looking forward to great upcoming events.

The Autocrat class will be held on Saturday, February 19, 2005 at the home of Mistress Susanna. Mistress Jessamyn will be covering the finer points of autocratting while I will be covering the forms and legalities of autocratting. Please RSVP directly to myself if you are attending.

This past month there were some questions brought up regarding policy, past decisions, etc. on the Baronial elist. Changes to policies and decisions made at a Baronial Meeting or by a Committee set up and voted upon at a Baronial meeting will not be made due to an email posted on the e-list. Any changes that anyone may feel needs to occur needs to be brought up at a Baronial Meeting. If you are unable to attend, you may submit your request via proxy – either written or by another person.

Runestone Collegium bids are due April 30th. We have not had a Runestone in two years. Please talk to your cantons, households, and friends to see if any one would like to put in a bid. The event is to be held some point in October. Please check for any Kingdom protected weekends before putting your bid in as well as any major Baronial events in the surrounding southern Baronies.

Minister of Minors Office is still open. This position will remain open until someone comes forward and puts in a letter of intent. This is a very important position that needs to be filled. Please take the time to consider if this is area in which you can contribute to the Barony.

Elkin - a polling was done of the populace in Elkin to inquire about Sacred Stone acquiring the lands surrounding Elkin. There was not a strong enough positive response returned to Dame Anne to approve that. We have not given up on that endeavor and will continue to

work towards that goal - it is just going to take a little more time.

A group in Elkin is working towards becoming a canton of Sacred Stone – they currently have regular fighter practices every Wed night and are going to begin having regular meetings and A&S nights. If anyone would like to offer assistance to them, please see me and I will get you the contact information for Bill Maudlin who is the person that has taken the position of organizing everything.

The Seneschal of Crannog Mor has contacted me about acquiring Sacred Stone lands that border Crannog Mor and are not currently a part of any of the Cantons of Sacred Stone – Wilkes County. Currently there are SCA members who reside in Wilkes County and play with Crannog Mor that would like their lands to become a part of Crannog Mor officially. We will proceed with the policies set forth by the Seneschallate about transferring that property. I don't know what the entire process will entail at this point in time, I will keep the Barony updated on progress and will be certain to bring any votes to the Barony that are required by the Seneschallate as soon as they need to be.

The Exchequer and I are going to come up with a form or set of guidelines of information you should have if you are going to request an expenditure of Baronial funds. Standard practice for that will be to submit the request one month, it will be published in The Phoenix, then the final vote for the expenditure will occur the next month. Unless of course it is something that needs to be approved more quickly than that and the Barony votes to waive the month of contemplation.

I would like to take a moment and thank everyone who came out to assist with building the new Baronial pavilions. Pictures will be posted on the Baronial website this month of that wonderful day!

Finally a friendly face saw my predicament and gave me garb from Golden Key (loaner garb). It was cool. It was a little short, but very form-fitting and flattering on me. It was a purple and yellow lace-up dress, maybe a bliout-I just remember feeling like a princess in it. I got more positive attention after putting on that dress!

Catlin, the lady who gave me the garb, took me in and treated me very nicely. She may have been chatelaine then. Catlin is still a friend of mine after 17 years in the SCA. She and I played recorders together and she showed me her hammered dulcimer. This was the first time I had ever seen one. I fell in love with it immediately and bought the dulcimer from her that Christmas!

We had a magical feast held inside Woodward Cave, with the constant temperature a cozy 42 degrees and water dripping down on us and our food and candles everywhere. Despite my new boyfriend's treatment, we stayed together a few months more. My relationship with the SCA, I'm happy to say, is lasting much longer.
