

April 17, 2005 Barony of the Sacred Stone Baronial Meeting Minutes

Coronet - Baroness Kisaiya:

- Still need a camp steward for the Pennsic encampment.
- The coronets of the surrounding baronies (Hidden Mountain, Hawkwood, Nottinghill Coill, Black Diamond and Windmaster's Hill) would like to create unity in the Southern Baronies.

Would the populace be willing to turn Runestone Collegium into a yearly event with the barony's rotating hosting duties. Since Sacred Stone is already working on a bid for this year, S.S. would be the host for this year. They would also like to host a yearly A&S event like In A Phoenix Eye. The baronial seneschal's are going to work out the logistics. They would also like to see a southern regional encampment at Sapphire Joust and Kingdom Crusades.

Seneschal - Asszony Rozsa:

- Runestone Collegium bids are due April 30th. Winter Solstice is due June 30th. Please talk to your cantons, households, and friends to see if any one would like to put in a bid. Please check for any Kingdom protected weekends before putting your bid in as well as any major Baronial events in the surrounding southern Baronies. No bids yet for either event. Try not to conflict with Kingdom events.
- Minister of Minors Office is still open.
- Publication permission forms are available for the Baronial Officers. I will try to have them with me; we need to have these on file with the Chronicler. Please be sure to sign one.
- Please remember if you are going to bring children to the event that are not your own children (age 17 and under) you must have a Medical Authorization form signed and notarized by the parents.
- Thank you again to Baron Achbar and his event staff. Everything ran very smoothly and we were all able to enjoy a pleasant day. Thank you to Walter Triplette as well for providing us with such a terrific event site!

Seneschal is stepping down as of this year's Baronial Birthday. Letters of intent for the position are being accepted by the current seneschal and the baroness starting June 1st.

About the Gazal:

The Ottoman Empire picked up a number of literary traditions from

it's ancestors (of a sort) in the Arabian Peninsula and Persia. Amongst them was the form of poetry known as gazal. Gazels, in period, were often used to praise Allah in allegorical forms, as the

one above. Said allegories also might have hid other meanings within the layers of metaphorical language, making them a difficult form to write, in and of themselves. Feel free to speculate on the layers in my work!

In addition, the form demands a very rigorous structure; couplets must be able to stand alone, yet work together in a thematic whole, a strict meter must be adhered to, along with a rhyming scheme, and so on. It makes for a teeth-gashing additional challenge to the process of making one, but makes the final product very satisfying, indeed.

I hope you find it enjoyable.
