* Baronial Exchequer reports balance of \$9066.80, including \$278 for the now ex-Baronial pavilion. Still need to allocate funds for upcoming Events

* Baronial Chatelaine is looking to improve advanced knowledge of demos throughout the Barony. He's also having issues with locating demos, and is actively seeking newcomers. Anyone who is willing to use his aid in their area, please ask!

* Baronial Webminister requests that all flyers for events and other activities be forwards to him, as well as contact information for all Baronial Officers and Champions

* Baronial Marshal reports all quiet

* Baronial Seneschal says that we must improve reporting and waiver gathering and record maintenance. Probation is a major threat at this point if these are not improved.

* We are in need of new Marshals for both Rapier and Archery

* Crois Bridge is now to big to meet in people's home, and has lots of archery going on. Runestone is being hosted by them in Nov.

* Hindscroft is hosting the Wastelands event next June, and has new fighters

* New Business:

*Asim is starting an A&S Revel, planned for the 3rd Wednesday in January. The first one will be Tudor-themed, and he is looking for a teacher or discussion leader in that area.

* War of the Wings:

* New idea for a InterBaronial-level War, planned to be held at the Elkin site in October 2006. Alain and Rozsa are co-autocrats, and the

war is with Windmaster's Hill. Katerina and Dunstan are coming up

with a story for the war, to be revealed over time. Cost is \$10 before Coronation, when \$5 is added, and there is no feast, nor a charge for kids.

* War of the Wings will have a large A&S competition, including Performing Arts, 2 Torchlight tourneys, and lots of fighting, overall. All competitions are war points. Baronages are encouraged to recruit allies early.

* Prize will be a War Banner

* Schedule will be hewed to strongly, as the plan is to have 2 castle battles, woods battle, champions tourney, and a last man standing grand melee. Also there will be youth combat, equestrian, rapier, siege weapons and combat archers, as well as possibly equestrian, site permitting. Most will be for war points

* Lots of advertising, with a PR coordinator (Katerina) working on it. * Pageantry War Point. A&S is "present to enter/win", and must be new material. MoAS is working with others on documentation classes.

*There will also be a Champions quest, run by Kisaiya, and both European and Middle Eastern Dance.
