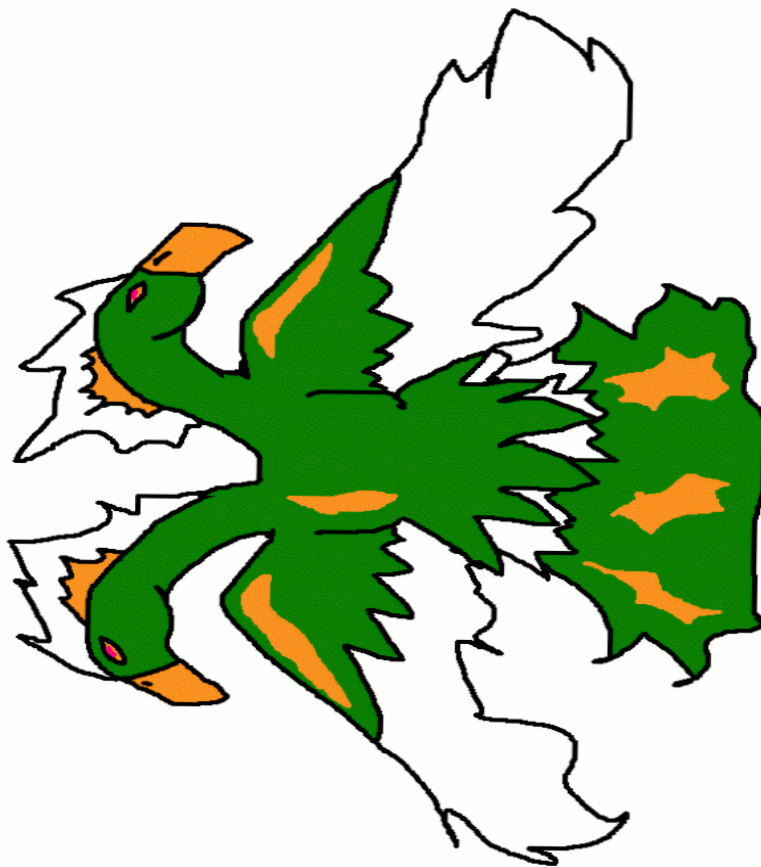

Greetings unto the populace of Sacred Stone from Marc and Alianor

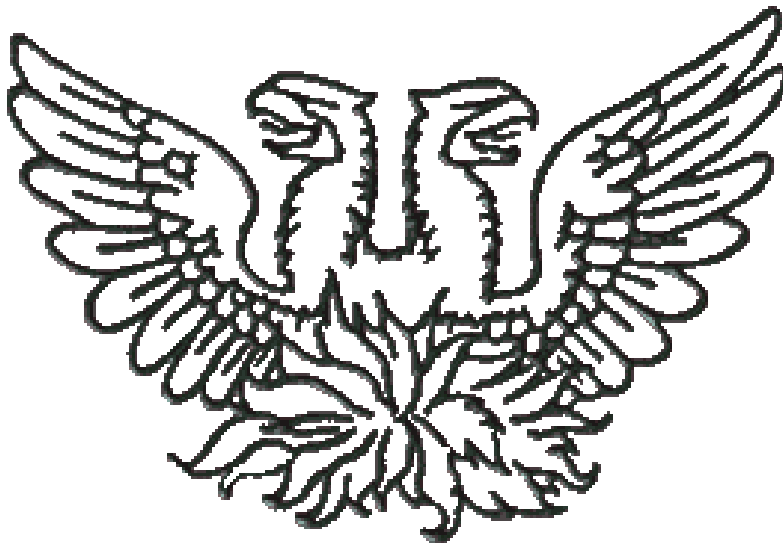
First we want to thank everyone for their great work over this past year. The wonderful folk of our Barony, have made our first year fun. We love you all; please keep up the great work.

In preparation for Gulf Wars the Barony of Sacred Stone announces an Inter-Baronial Practice to be held in Elkin, NC, Sunday, February 18, 2007, (that's the Sunday the week after Ymir, for those of you keeping score at home) at Elchenburg Castle in Booneville, NC, recently the site of War of the Wings I.

This practice will take place regardless of weather conditions, as an alternate site just a few miles away has sufficient indoor space to permit such.

Since Atlantia is so rarely able to bring its armies together in sufficient numbers to allow a war practice this will be a WAR practice and not simply a large singles combat practice. (While we're sure there will be singles practice, it is not intended to be the main focus of the day.)

Feasting With the Phoenix

This month's recipe is a little 'nip' to keep you warm.
From Forme of Cury we have a fairly simple mulled wine called Clarrey.

Clarrey

PERIOD: England, 14th century | SOURCE: Forme of Cury | CLASS: Authentic

DESCRIPTION: Wine mulled with honey and spices

ORIGINAL RECIPT:

205. Clarrey. Take kanel & galinga, greyns de paris, and a lytel peper, & make pouder, & temper hit wyt god wyte wyne & the prid perte honey & ryne hit þorow a cloþ.

GODE COOKERY TRANSLATION:

Claret. Take cinnamon & galingale, grains of paradise, and a little pepper, & make powder, & mix it with good white wine & the third part honey & run it through a cloth.

MODERN RECIPE:

- 1 bottle (750 ml) of an inexpensive, sweet white wine
- 1 -2 cups honey
- 1 tbs. each cinnamon, galingale (or substitute ginger), & cardamom
- 1 tsp. white pepper
- cheesecloth

Bring the wine and honey to a boil; reduce heat & skim off the scum as it rises. Taste for sweetness; add honey as necessary. Remove from heat, stir in spices, and allow to sit covered for 24 hours. After sitting, the spices will create a thick residue which will settle to the bottom. Using a ladle, pass the wine into another container through a strainer lined with 2 or 3 layers of cheesecloth to remove the spices, being careful to leave as much of the spice residue in the pot as possible. Bottle. Make at least 1 month before serving. A good *Clarrey* aged for a year or more is exquisite!

Clarrey was wine to which honey and spices were added; the name comes from the Latin *vinum claratum*, which means "clarified wine." The name survives today as *claret*, a dry, red wine.

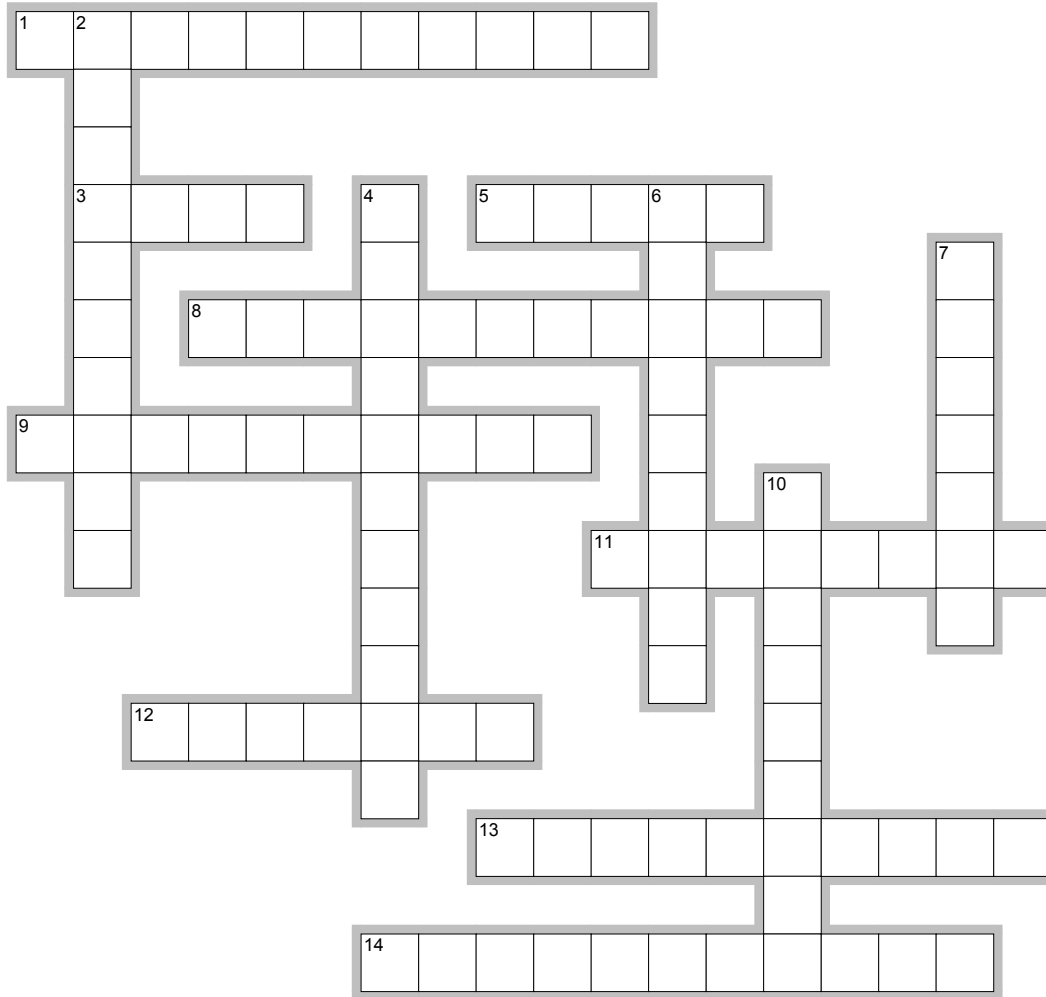

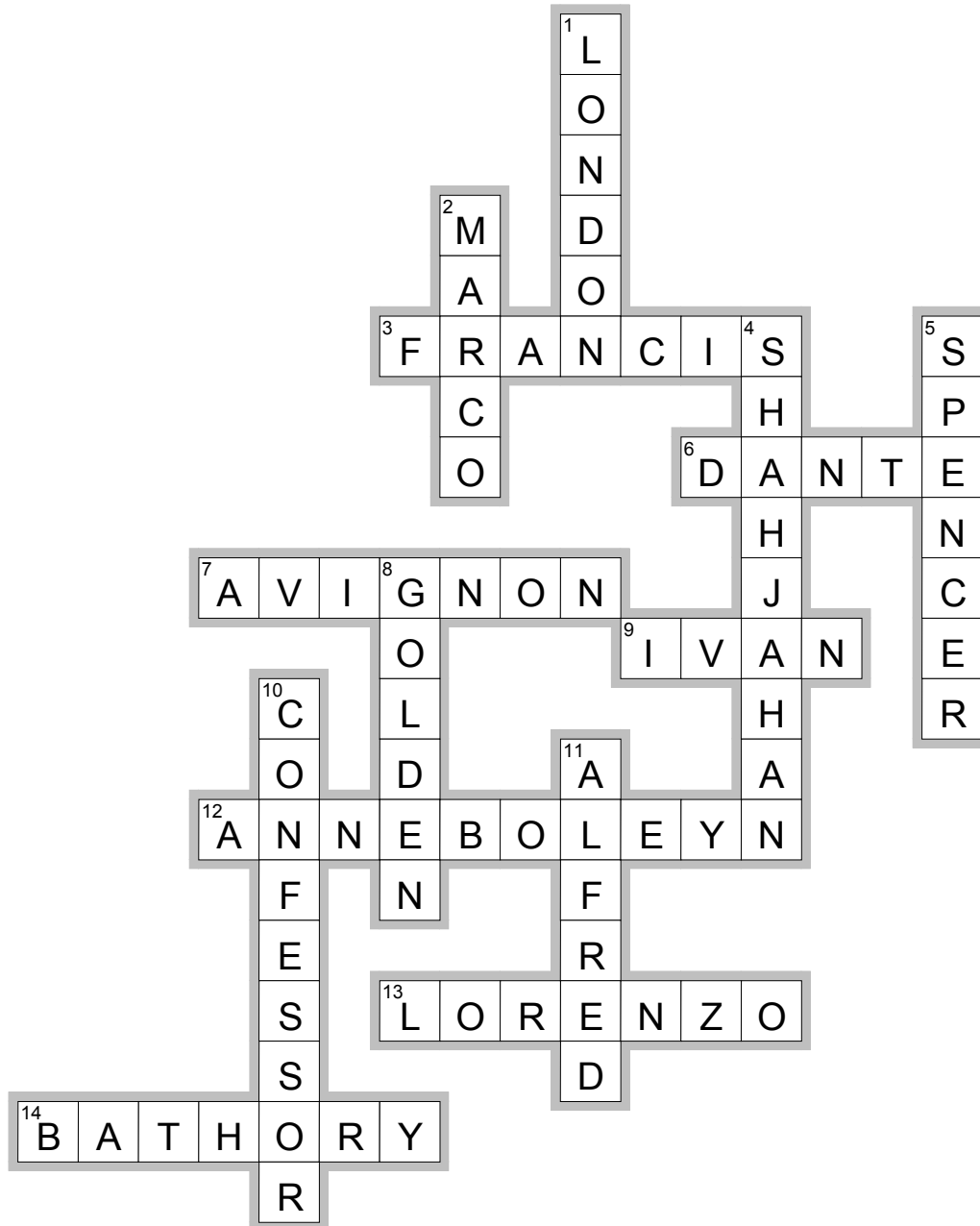
