Baronial Meeting Minutes

(as recorded by Lady Gisella)

The Sacred Stone Baronial monthly meeting was held in the music room of Bunker Hill High School at 1 pm Sunday, April 22. Seneschal Robear/Bob Harvey called the meeting to order about 1:20 pm. About two dozen people were in attendance including Baronne Alianor atte Redswanne/Jean Wagner, Knights Marshal and Castelaine Achbar ibn Ali/James Morrow, MoAS Susanna von Schwesisguth. Robear opened the meeting with thanks to all who helped, attended and supported Coronation. He further stated that the baronial coffers are healthy, in large part due to well-supported and successfully run events. An exact figure will be announced at the next baronial meeting, after the transition is complete.

A new bank account was opened last year to smooth the transition of the books from one exchequer to another. Since it was established, the new account has nearly as much money as the old account has. He further asked that if anyone in the barony has suggestions for 'sensible' purchases that "will help or be used by all the cantons" that these folks make their suggestions known to he and Their Excellencies for consideration.

In considering possible baronial purchases the following discussions took place: The purchase of the new baronial pavilion is moving forward. Alianor will contact Panther to get the final quote. It was pointed out that Real Leather, a merchant who carries Panther pavilions and sells at Pennsic, has offered to give a good price as well. Alianor will get the prices and move forward with the most responsible purchase. Robear stated the barony has long wanted a "nice double list fence" similar to that owned by Windmasters Hill and others in the region. The problem in making one is that those with the skill and tools don't always have the time, or don't always have the time when others with similar skills and tools do. "We've got the money," he stated, "Let's have somebody else do it." He suggested Olaf, who's created such fences before. Alain suggested we ask for bids and different designs from several people. Susanna made the motion to get a bid for a fence that the barony would then organize to paint. Bonnie seconded that bid. The ayes were unanimous. Susanna asked if there was a limit the financial committee (which consists of the officers of the barony) could authorize and Robear and Alianor stated that there was no limit.

Robear listed a few other purchases being considered or already made.

1) Feast gear for future events so the barony doesn't have to borrow from neighbors.

2) Walkie-talkies have been purchased and are available to event staffs. Batteries will need to be purchased or cared for.

3) The next two years for baronial storage unit will be paid for.

4) Shelves need to be purchased for the storage unit.

At this point the conversation turned to the need to inventory the baronial storage unit, a task that has been pushed back by time constraints on members of the barony for several months. Those able and willing will get together on Sunday, June 3 to inventory and place shelves in the storage unit. Gottfried will purchase the shelves and bring them to the unit that day. If you have any baronial items, please make sure they get back to the storage unit by then. If you need any items from the storage unit, please make sure you sign them out. Alain is the contact for the storage unit.

OFFICERS' REPORTS:

This essentially served as the Chamberlain's report and next Robear moved to the HERALD'S REPORT which was to say the barony needs a new herald. Edward Shirebrook agreed to serve as the acting baronial herald until letters from interested persons might be received considered and a decision made. Anyone interested in the position must be or become a duly warranted herald, file appropriate reports and assist the barony, her officers and coronets and other heralds with heraldic matters in a timely fashion. Letters are due to Robear and Mark and Alianor by May 20.

EXCHEQUER: Given by Robear as Rufus Piggeboy/Walter Triplette could not attend. Rufus is working with the appropriate officers to finalize the quarterly report for the barony. The coffers are healthy.

KNIGHTS MARSHAL: Achbar ibn Ali – He reports the updated rules on gorget and elbow protection requirements are being implemented within the barony as across the kingdom. He declared the need for more marshals for upcoming events, especially baronial birthday and War of the Wings II. There are three individuals working on becoming rapier marshals. MoAS: Susanna von Schweisguth – She has recently taken the office and is very excited about the possibilities. When teased about taking the office, she replied, "If I didn't want to do it, I wouldn't have offered to." She added, "I hate whining (about what should be done), especially in my own head." She was thanked for her willingness to serve. She wants to put a lot of useful information on the baronial web page and asked for suggestions, ideas and content from the populace. She further reported upcoming A&S activities at events in the barony. None will be judged competitions but will, instead, be "really thorough displays" with helpful comments from qualified artisans and tokens being given. Wastelands, June 23 at Elchenburg Castle has a Byzantine theme Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday, August 24-26 at Elchenburg Castle has a Silk Road theme, War of the Wings II, October 12-14 at Elchenburg Castle will have the same categories as last year with a different structure. More information will be anounced as it is available. She further stated there are several cantons in the barony that have regular A&S activities. She is

gathering this information and will publish the dates, times and locations so everyone will have a chance to get out and meet folks, make things and learn.

MoL: Pam – reported nothing new

CHATELAIN: Achbar ibn Ali – He has observed at the last several events that newcomers are "being garbed, taken to events and shown around. In my opinion, that's as it should be." He would like to see non-event, informal SCA 'meet-ups' with pictures and items for people who are interested in the Society to look at and people to ask questions of. He asked for others to consider such get-togethers. He has a deputy for garb, Eva Liao/Megan Webb who will take charge of Gold Key. Robear stated that Charlesbury Crossing has five tubs of sorted and labeled Gold Key they will be storing in the baronial storage unit to which all cantons are welcomed on the understanding the clothing will be laundered and returned in the same sorted and neat condition.

WEB MINISTER was not present and no report sent.

CANTON ACTIVITIES:

AIRE FAUCON – Nothing New

BEALFIRE DUNN – Gottfried reported the group has weekly gatherings, a demo on Friday April 27 at a

local elementary school's spring festival. Also the canton is putting on Below the Salt May 12. Reyna, the autocrat, declared, "It's gonna be great! Go!" The feast is nearly sold out, the Hat Rack is being resurrected, several heavy and rapier tourneys and woods battles, target archery and a party Saturday night . . . Awesome prizes, including painted Spike banners and painted goblets, a treasure hunt and coins . . .which will be different from last year's coins so don't try to combine saved coins from last year with new coins from this year. They're already ahead of you on that trick, bucko! CHARLESBURY CROSSING has a new seneschal in Callidor who is a brewer and was therefore deemed a worthy holder of the office by the assembled group. Bonnie Harvey, just past seneschal has stepped out of the office to serve as the North Carolina Regional Seneschal. She wants to assure anyone who has an issue they might not feel comfortable taking to her as the Regional officer that they can contact the kingdom seneschal directly with no worries. CROIS BRIGTE – Is planning an archery only event on Sept 8 at Elchenburg Castle and the petition to expand the zip code boundaries of the canton is awaiting the last of neighboring canton's signatures and then will be sent on to the Kingdom Seneschal for approval. HINDSCROFT – Aelfwynn av Bornholm reports the canton has several new officers including Seneschal – Isabeau, Exchequer – Simon of Ipswich, and Herald – herself. Also Glory Wars, an event from years ago, has been resurrected and will be

held Sept 15 at the Elchenburg Castle. Achbar is the MiC and has a Novice Tourney planned as well as a special activity for knights and newer fighters. Contact Achbar for more

information. The March demo was very successful, made front-page of the news paper and garnered three new paid members for the group. Raven reports the group is looking forward to participating in the Stokes Stomp again in October, Celebrate the Past and have been asked back for other events in Stokes County.

SALISBURY GLENN – Robear spoke with Axel before the meeting. Axel was very pleased with St. Urho's

Day event which made a profit for the canton. Several people in the meeting agreed the event was 'great fun' and looked forward to next year's rendition.

OLD BUSINESS:

Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday is schedule August 24-26 at the Elchenburg Castle Site. Achbar is planning a Five-man Bear Pit with a limit of no more then two knights per team, a Novice Tourney, Torchlit Tourney Friday night and Rapier activities. Archery, equestrian and A&S activities are also planned. The Great Dark Horde has agreed to set up an encampment, teach classes and

will be sponsoring A&S and marital competitions. Groups and individuals who wish to represent other cultures involved with and

affected by the trade routes called the Silk or Spice Road are encouraged to teach classes or hold some activity at the event in keeping with the them of the trade between East and West. NEW BUSINESS:

Rozsa asked if the barony would increase its annual donation to buy snacks for the Children's Fete at Pennsic from \$100 to \$150. After brief discussion about success of the event and the number of individuals who have spent their personal money to replenish the snacks when they've run out, it was decided to donate \$200 for this purpose. Susanna encouraged everyone who wished to do so, to send a check to the Kingdom Exchequer in support of the Children's Fete but to be sure to write Children's Fete on the check.

NEXT MEETING – The regular meeting date for May will fall on Memorial Day weekend and during Sapphire Joust. It was decided to move the event to June 3 at the Inventory Count of the Baronial Storage Unit. June's meeting will take place at Elcheburg Castle June 24 after Wastelands clean up. July's meeting is canceled because of Pennsic. August's meeting will be at Elchenburg Castle on August 26 after SSBB cleanup.

CORONET REPORT:

Alianor reiterated the Baronial Calendar needs to be updated to reflect changes made. This will be looked into. Lady Catherine St. Loe has stepped down as head lady in waiting due to family concerns. She is greatly thanked for her service to the barony and our coronets and populace. Lady Brenna has agreed to serve as Head Lady in Waiting and also Land Steward for the baronial Pennsic Encampment. There will be a baronial court at Pennsic followed by the Second Annual Baronial Pennsic Luau.

The meeting was adjourned to various activities such as sewing, post meeting meetings, fighter practice and rapier.




