Greetings to all of the Knowne World both far and near, all those who participate in the Performing Arts and all those who enjoy the talents and skills of watching the Performing Arts. The Performing Arts War Point Competition for the War of the Wings IV will be as follows:

ALL PERFORMING ARTS DISCIPLINES ARE ENCOURAGED TO PARTICIPATE! We invite all those who sing, dance, juggle, play musical instruments, write poetry, tell stories, and perform plays and dramatic readings to come and be a part of the competition. Groups are also encouraged!

THERE IS NO REQUIREMENT TO INCORPORATE THE WOW THEME SO ALL ENTRIES ARE WELCOME! Due to the fact that WOW IV is only a few weeks away, we are opening the competition to any and all entries, whether they follow the WOW Theme ("Missiles") or not. Extra points will be awarded to those who are able to incorporate the theme, but it is not required. There will be three rounds of competition: 1) Participant's Choice - you may choose your own favorite, even if it is one that you have done many times before and any style. 2) Levity Encouraged - you may choose any piece that makes us laugh or has a "feel good" element to it. 3) Inspirational - you may choose any piece that would inspire us all to greatness, whether it be in war, in love, or in the arts.

THERE WILL BE MANY OPPORTUNITIES TO WIN! There will be judges from all the disciplines to be sure that the outcome is as fair and balanced as can be. Each entry will be scored on ORIGINALITY, SKILL LEVEL, INCORPORATION OF WOW THEME, PRESENTATION, ENTERTAINMENT VALUE, and DOCUMENTATION. So if you are unable to pull together documentation, you can make up your score in one of the other areas and so on. This is also a great way for new performers to receive great educational feedback from some of the Kingdom's most talented performers. A winner will be selected in each of the scoring areas and one OVERALL WINNER will be named. Each winner will receive a prize and the overall winner will also receive a War Point for the Team of their choice.

The event will begin at 1:00 pm and the winners will be announced in evening Court. Embattled: battled, battelly, crenelled, or kernelled: a line of partition resembling a row of battlements, (from which it derived its origin and its name) across the shield; the term may also be applied to the edge of an ordinary.

Emblazon: to draw out in full and colour a coat of arms from a description. Reverse of to blazon.

August Business Meeting

August 27th- Bunker Hill High School

Meeting began at 1:21pm

Coronet Report- Coronets need polishing. Need gemstones for awards. Will post to the list exactly what we need. Synthetic is okay.

Thank you to everyone who made the effort to go to Pennsic. Everyone is welcome to camp with the Barony next year. Sheet walls were very nice.

Officers' Reports:

Seneschale's report: Gisela – Pennsic Report, Pennsic went very well. Artists: Virag and Lidia showed at Pennsic. Sacred Stone provided about ½ of the southern army of Atlantia. SS was the significant part of the children's fete. 444 children attended. Huge success. Again thank you to those who were at Pennsic. Potential of stepping down early. Might be taking the Golden Dolphin Herald position. Online is the best way to get me with any questions about this.

Exchequer's report: Dubhghall - \$7709.01

Our funds are going downward. We need to be careful and looking at our decisions. Manus suggests that we try to get back to \$10,000 as a good floating balance. Tal suggested slightly raising our profit margins while keeping the cost of events affordable.

MoAS: Lidia de Ragusa - ~~Will not be at meeting due to death in the family~~ “I know some members of Sacred Stone successfully displayed in the A&S at Pennsic. I know for sure myself and Virag did. I would be glad to get brief reports from anyone else that displayed at Pennsic.”

Chatelaine: Serena (Formerly known as Ommari) - Newest member of Barony Logan Scott Cole, Serena's grandson. There is a new Newcomers pamphlets made by Caitlin. We will need people to sign up to help with Chatelaine table at SSBB. She will not be there.

Knights Marshal: Achbar ibn Ali – Wants to teach more marshaling classes both combat archery and heavy. Will be teach in other baronies as well. We need more marshals.

MoL: Alexandria – Nothing to report. Currently not warranted.

Chirurgion: Gwynwylf - Hello, hope everyone was safe at Pennsic. CiC at SSBB and CaL at WOW. Hopefully will be teaching classes at University. Wants to teach one on fire extinguisher use.

Old Business:

- 1) Baronial Encampment Gate: Sheet walls – Still Need Aire Faucon's for WoW. How did it work?
Barony purchased 6 portable holes for walls. Thank Dubhghall for letting us use the Horse Gate.
- 2) Baronial Dayshade Cover: What are we doing with this?
Have done nothing with it yet.
- 3) Baronial Shower: How did it work? Final cost? Provided hot water but need to work with them. Garden hoses NOT good for hot water heater. Brock did a great job putting it together. Propane tanks were supposed to be included but were purchased by Axel and Jeanmarie.
We are willing to store them. WOW will buy the contents of the full one, the barony will reimburse the other.
- 4) Kingdom Archery Championships: Still waiting for correct bill from Surry Portajon
Should have one on Monday.

- 5) Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday: Web page, schedule, champions competitions
Not far off. NEED Volunteers in several areas, Troll, Clean-up, Marshal, MoL
Camp Cherokee. Want to have an atlatl battle. Checking on hay bails for that. Championships will be
announced on the e-list.
- 6) WoW.- Is coming!! If weather is bad, attendance will be low and we might lose money. If not, we might continue
to increase in attendees. Trying to balance preparing for 1000 people and not spending a lot of money.
Middlegate is taking on ALL Portapotties and the bath house.

Silent auction needs help too. Need stuff to auction. SUPPORT THIS!!!!!! Gise challenges us to make this the BEST
income fundraiser for Susan B Coman this year. Torchlight tourney will be held also.

Manus is land steward for WOW. It needs to get in soon!!!!

Printing materials need to get to Caitlin asap. Also, Friday night social still happening. Need help with the Friday evening
social. Heather Dale might be coming. People need to register your pet with Gate.

7) Electronic Payment (ACCEPS) – Working well.

New Business:

1) Officer Term Limits – To avoid burn-out (realized and unrealized) To give others a chance to serve.
To create a situation where more people will learn the requirements of running the barony. To decrease the burden on
those willing to serve.
Proposal: Two-year terms with two one-year re-ups. Preferably next person interested will serve as deputy for one year.

Seneschal and Exchequer (which are required) the office will go vacant.
