Arm Guard or Not?

By Baron Christophe of Grey

So there is this ongoing discussion of string slap and archers. String slap is when the bow string smacks your bow arm forearm upon release. I've seen some really technicolored forearms because of this! Usually the suggested fix is to bend your bow arm. But this leads to really bad archery form leading to inconsistent results. So let's talk about how to fix the problem.

String slap is a product of your bow's brace height. That is the distance between the string at rest and the arrow pass, where the arrow rests on the bow at release. Recurve bows typically start at about 8 inches. Longbows typically start at about 6 inches. That 2 inches makes a huge difference! When you release the string to shoot the arrow the string actually over recovers. That means if your brace height is 6 inches, the string may recover to less than 6 inches before stabilizing to its resting position. Now consider the angle of your bow arm and the bow. This over recovery of the bow string brings your arm into that area of recovery.

The next issue is gender based. I don't know why but ladies tend to be more flexible than men. Thus when we hold our arm out to hold the bow for a shot with ladies the bow arm elbow tends to over flex, thereby bring the forearm just below the elbow into the path of the string. Now for both genders this can be an issue. Try this. Without your bow, raise your bow arm and point to a target with your index finger while holding your hand perpendicular to the ground. Notice the joint of your elbow is most likely pointing upwards at about 45 degrees. Now try to rotate your elbow so this joint is perpendicular to the ground while keeping your bow hand, with pointing index finger, vertical. Kinda hard, isn't it? Now try this, arm to your side. Begin the raise of your bow arm by throwing your shoulder of that arm forward as you raise your bow arm to point at the target. You should notice that your elbow joint is now perpendicular to the ground as it should be.

Ah ha! So this is the fix? Not always. In a speed round or even just general shooting sometimes we forget to throw the shoulder to initiate the draw. If speed is not the issue, let down the draw and bow and start over. Sooner or later it becomes instinct.

Now next issue, and specific to ladies, bruising above the elbow joint. I say specific to ladies due to the gender flexibility issue. If initiating the draw motion as described above does not fix the problem you will need an arm guard/bracer that covers above your elbow as well. I've seen these and they are usually somewhat hinged at the elbow so your bow arm is not like having a cast on it.

The next issue contributing to string slap is your bow. As mentioned above, recurve bows have a larger brace height than longbows. If you shoot a recurve and your technique is good you can go sans arm guard. If you get snapped by the string it serves as a reminder that your technique was flawed. With longbows, due to the lower brace heights and the angle of your bow arm, you need an arm guard/bracer.

Now there is, of course, the item that wearing an arm guard/bracer just looks so terribly archery! It's part of the bling of the sport. They can be really fancy, really simple, have your device on it, plain or tooled or stamped. In period they were often given as awards to archers of exception.

Happenings at Elchenburg Castle!!

Happy Winter from Elchenburg Castle!! In an effort to cut through all the rigamarole and second-hand news, Elchenburg Castle, Inc. will now be writing a regular article in this very baronial newsletter to keep our Scadian friends and benefactors informed and involved in the continuing efforts to build the best and coolest SCA site in the Knowne World. This article is the second episode of this new adventure. Here you'll find all the news, announcements, and sometimes mullings which happen on a pretty-constant basis at the only SCA-dedicated site (of over 50 acres) outside of Mississispi! Let's begin be reviewing the progress since last month's article: Herrin Gisela is still working on the economic impact data, and so far *zero* people have replied to the question of "Should Elchenburg Castle, Inc. permit the construction of permanent structures, such as is permitted at the site of Gulf Wars?" So, the assumption must be that no one who read the article had a strong opinion on that topic. What, you do? Then voice it! (To permit you to respond anonymously, names will be withheld upon request.)

So what's new? Well, the single-largest development has been courtesy of the Shire of Seareach. Here's a quote of their post on the Kingdom of Atlantia's Facebook page:

"Elchenburg Castle is in need. A majority of the saplings planted on their majestic fields either succumbed to drought, or were damanged during War of the Wings. Rather than allow the fields where our brethren fought to remain bare, the Shire of Seareach has issued a challenge to every Household, Shire, Keep, Canton and Barony in the great Kingdom of Atlantia. A tree. The Nursery at TyTy (tytyga.com) has 10-foot southern and northen red oaks that you can purchase and have shipped to Elchenburg Castle to be planted in honor of your group or an individual. The cost of the trees with shipping are approximately \$150 each. Trees are shipped dormant usually December thru April, weather dependent. Trees should be shipped to: Elchenburg Castle c/o David Stewart, 2239 Center Road, Boonville, NC 27011. Imagine the legacy beautiful oak would be. Trees for Elchenburg, challenge Atlantia."

The Shire of Seareach sponsored the first tree. This endeavor is stunning in its generosity. And Master Ursus, on behalf of the Bog Troopers, sponsored a tree in response.

What can Elchenburg Castle do to show its gratitude? The only thing it *can* do: Invite a gathering! So here's the plan: When Elchenburg Castle is notified of the arrival time of the trees, there will be a free (donations only) "flash event" announced for that weekend! Whether this becomes an "SCA event" versus " SCA practice" versus "non-SCA gathering" depends on whether the necessary marshals, etc. can be mustered in time. Note that some areas will not be part of the "SCA thingee," so if there's something you'd like to come and demonstrate, you're free to do so.

What else happened during November? Well, there have been a couple procedural changes. For one, in response to requests there's now a new event check-in / check-out process. The forms will be posted on the Elchenburg Facebook page, and comments/suggestions are welcomed, there or via e-mail. Second, Elchenburg Castle will now follow the examples set by other campsites and help event organizers interact with portajon and dumpster rental companies. It can be a great convenience for event organizers if Elchenburg conducts all the pre-event and post-event interactions with those companies.
