There is a new Society Marshal's Handbook out... December 2015 edition.

This is not a rewrite of the rules, but a cleanup, incorporating the changes that have occurred since the previous version was published.

See http://www.sca.org/officers/marshal/docs/marshal handbook.pdf

The following are the differences that I have found:

Removal of section VII, A, 16

(Weapons under 48" (1.22 m) or greater than 7' 6" (2.29 m) in length may have either a thrusting tip or a butt spike, but not both at the same time...)

Change section VII, E, 2

Revise the size requirement for thrusting tips for throwing weapons, changing from 2"x2" to 1.5"x1.5".

Change section VII, G, 7

Modify the shaft requirement for heavy ammunition for Combat Archery to specify 100 PSI or greater Siloflex Equivalent rather than just 100 PSI Siloflex Equivalent.

Remove section VII, D, 5-8

Delete section 5, renumber, for the purpose of eliminating a manufacturer's name (Mandrake) Renumber sections VII, D, 6-8 to 5-7.

Remove section X, B, 1, b

Delete the recommendation that the Marshal in Charge for a war not be a member of a group on the field


