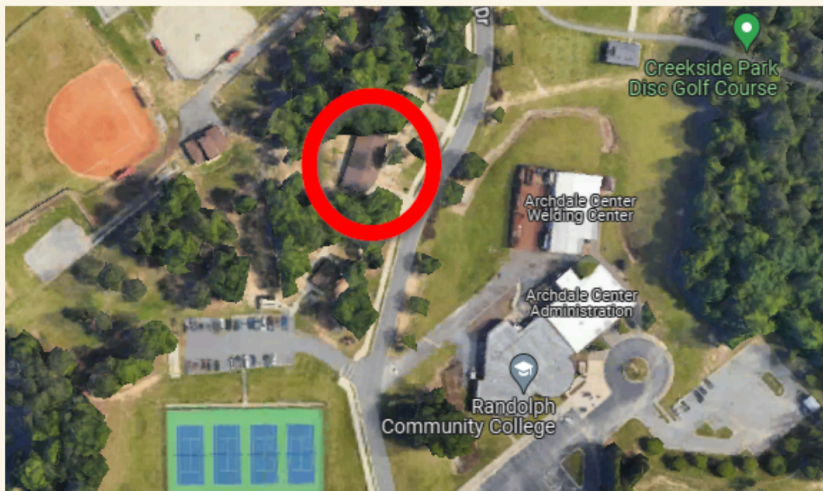

The Populace of Sacred Stone- our noble excellencies and our great Seneschal Master Patris need your aid! The barony is currently in need of:

Baronial Clerk Signet

The position involves: Working with the Baron and Baroness for scroll assignments / awards, working with the other scribes of the Barony for handling assignments, working with the MOAS for planning scroll competitions at events, and working with the Baronial Herald.

Minister of the Lists (or deputy)

Minister of the List is a position within the Marshal structure to organize and document tournaments, record fighter authorizations and report the results in an unbiased fashion.

A Minister of the List (MoL) helps organize, complete and maintain the paperwork needed to track fighters' authorizations and run combat scenarios at events. They are the people sitting at the table on the side of the list field signing in combatants, checking authorization cards, recording authorizations, and filling out all those lovely forms necessary to keep fighting in Atlantia running smoothly.

Deputy Exchequer

The exchequer serves as the group treasurer. Becoming a deputy is a good way to learn how the office works!

Deputy Seneschal

A seneschal in the Society for Creative Anachronism is an administrative officer and the modern equivalent of a president or chief operating officer

Field reports from Rumors of War: Interkingdom Fighter Practice

Armored Champion's Report

This weekend past (June 21-23) the fighters of Sacred Stone upon hearing of Rumors of War; led by their Warlord, Sir Cyriac Grimsdale, and Heavy Champion, Lord Domnall Locard, traveled to the mountains of North Carolina. They were accompanied by Duke Bryan of Sacred Stone and Sir Feargus MacAirt as a heavy fighting force, and Master Raphael de la Rosa and m'lord Cailean MacQueen on the rapier field. However, The fighters were not the only ones to make the trip Mistress Lidia de Ragusa was ever present along with Lady Bailey Storm, Master Robert Shockley of Avonsford, Mistress Annora Hall, and many others whom this fighter can not recall names at the time of writing. Baron Roibeard Mac Oscar took arms with the Sacred Stone fighters to represent on the field. On the heavy field Sacred Stone fighters had the single largest showing of force, showing we are a force to be reckoned with.

The skies were clear and provided a pleasant view of the surrounding mountains at the battlefield. However, one of the hardest opponents to battle was the blazing overhead sun. It was a mighty foe and did a number on all those in attendance.

The fighters of all forms took to the field in battle scenarios sharpening their skills to be ready for any upcoming battle in the heat of the next few months. Rapier fighters perform drills and spear battles and multiple melee challenges to ensure their blades are ever ready. The heavy fighters worked on skills and endurance in the heat and altitudes they were not normally accustomed to with a bear pit style battle where each bout was fought best two of three. All the Sacred Stone fighters, and populous in attendance represented the Barony with chivalry and grace ensuring all honor entering the day was returned with at the end.

Once the training completed, meals and camaraderie were had in such ways to continue the bonding and show the strength of Sacred Stone both on and off the field. From the road this fighter is proud of the showing we had and the way our populace represented the grace of our Baronnes and the skill of our Baron. Armored Warlord's Report

Goodness gravy it was HOT. "Hotlantia" really lived up to its name this weekend in Aiken South Carolina.

Lord Edward Perry (John Patrick Brice Jr) and myself loaded up and headed down Friday night so we could be close to site on Saturday morning. When loading up the vehicle, I at first thought - oh this will all fit in the Prius, the car that can just sip gas on the way down and back and make nary a scratch on the gas gauge. As my husband (who doesn't play in the SCA) was helping me load up the car, we quickly determined that it would not in fact fit in the Prius no matter how much we "tetrised" it (and I am a master Tetris player when it comes to packing). We unloaded what we had packed in the car and transferred it all over to the Jeep. Back seats down, the whole rear compartment was full to the gills. We really couldn't put anything else in there. Edward arrived at my house, and we loaded ourselves up into the "brick on wheels" and made our way south to Aiken.

Neither of us had ever been to Aiken before so we weren't really sure what to expect as far as the town size or where things were laid out (beyond what we could see on Google maps). We arrived later in the night so we weren't really able to see what downtown looked like and all. We arrived at our motel and checked in and quickly called it a night.

Saturday morning came and we made haste to get everything ready and head to the site. We had to make a quick stop at the local Kroger for some items on our grocery list that we hadn't gotten yet along with 4 more bags of ice. We got some looks while walking through the produce section at Kroger with us in our garb.... as one does. We even had some people ask us why we were dressed like we were. We told them about the event at Virginia Akers Park and they seemed interested. There was so much going on that day that I wasn't able to pay attention to see if I recognized any of the faces we saw at the grocery store.

We arrived on site and met with the event Steward, forgive me as I'm not sure what their SCA name is,

but mundanely, its Yancy Holt. He pointed us in the right direction of where we would be set up and acquired us some helping hands to help unload the Jeep of all the gear we brought with us to setup for the day which was much appreciated <3 .

Once my makeshift kitchen was setup and ready I started cutting fresh fruit and getting my prep work taken care of before starting to cook on the grill. We cut up 2 watermelons, 2 cantaloupes, 3 pineapples (boy they were so ripe and delicious!), destemmed a bag of grapes and cut 2 boxes (I think they were either 1# or 2# each) of strawberries. Everything except for the hamburgers, hot dogs, buns and condiments were prepped on site. Lord Edward helped get things organized on the picnic tables on the shelters and my chafing pan ready so I could light the cannisters to keep the meats warm as well as make the Gatorade cooler full of iced green tea and assist with washing up as we went so there was less work at the end in regards to dirty dishes. He also masterfully cut the cantaloupes up which he said he had never cut up before. I made a massive pan of homemade banana pudding as a secondary dessert, that was a huge hit with the populace!

We seemed to time it just perfectly - everything was ready right at 12:30 for our Majesties and their retinue to come grab some lunch from our 2-table long buffet. Shortly after, staff came and made a plate for their lunch and then we opened it up to the populace to come make a plate for lunch as well.

I'm really glad I had the forethought to bring the inflatable serving bars and the fly fans with me. The inflatable serving bars, were filled with ice and helped keep everything nice and cold. I had lots of comments on my setup, especially about the inflatable serving bars. Someone said it was genius idea! The populace really appreciated that the meats were kept hot and liked the general organization of how the line was setup.

When Lord Edward asked me to assist in a day board for the Royals and their retinue something like 5 weeks ago, I jumped on board because he said he would like some help. We collaborated back and forth about what to make/what to serve and how to present it. We mulled over every little detail several times over and then ultimately decided on keeping it simple and cooking out with hot dogs and hamburgers with fixings and sides and not stress about it near as much. I love to cook out in general and

knew I could pull that off without any issues.

I thought the fresh fruit would be an excellent idea since we knew it was going to be hot and it would help provide hydration and sustenance to those attending. While our day board was certainly not "period" by any means, especially with how it was setup (aside from the food unless you want to consider hot dogs as medieval sausages or something ;-)), it was quite the success and everyone really liked the offerings.

This was Lord Edward and I's first time ever doing something such as this. We were a bit nervous but we jumped in feet first and pulled it off successfully in a relatively short amount of time. We didn't count the numbers, but we served at least 100 people between the hot dogs and hamburgers and probably more who just came for the fruit and banana pudding. With all that we brought, there was minimal wastage which I was pleasantly surprised at. Everything went extremely smooth for us and I couldn't be happier!

We had mostly everything broken down and ready to load back into the jeep before afternoon court and finished up right after court closed. We thanked the Event Steward and others that we saw for allowing us to serve their Barony and offered our services again for next year.

All in all, not bad for a first go. I'm truly grateful for Lord Edward's invitation to assist and his company over the weekend. He was a true gem throughout the whole event and helped keep the gears of the operation running smoothly.

Chatelaine –(Lady Siobhan inghean mhic Eochadha) : We had our first meeting with Kingdom Chatelaine (Megan Ladd). She is looking to get every chatelaine on FB/email list Kingdom-wide chatelaine meetings are currently the last Thursday of the month. For demos Kingdom would like to have google form with name/email/zip code. This will allow us to know roughly where people are located so we can reach out appropriately.

Would still like to do a garb workshop, likely after Pennsic due to my busy schedule. Would like to have this set up for new people to help them out with sewing and learning to make their own garb.

Plan to go to conventions in garb and pass out cards/talk about what we do. Getting new people's information is helpful to be about to reach out because coming to a new event can be intimidating.

If you would like me to reach out to new people or you have any questions, reach out to me and let me know so I can help out.

Kingdom War Practice in July – no cost, so this can be a good place for a new person to show up and check us out. Probably can even show up without garb and just take a look around with no pressure.

Marshal (Syr Garan): no report, not in attendance

Minister of the Lists (MoL) (Lady Niccolina the Wanderer) : not in attendance, no report (out of state)

Chronicler: (Slaine inghean ui Sheachnsaigh): We would like to look into using Canva. The pro subscription service would allow for a much higher quality product to make newsletters and other pieces of media for the barony.

Cost of pro would be \$120 per person. This subscription would go to the individual's computer but should be able to be transferred when the office of chatelain changes hands. Proposal to consider would be for 2 subscriptions - one for the chronicler and another for the deputy. There is a nonprofit option. (on further research after the meeting this would not be a feasible option as the SCA as a whole only gets 8 licenses to use worldwide as a nonprofit) Questions brought by members of the populace are if there is option to share amongst cantons/barony if there is an organizational account to reduce total cost. And make sure that the account can be transferred easily if the chronicler were to disappear without contact.

This will be bookmarked to do more research and discuss at the next meeting.

Minister of Arts and Science (Just Pagane and Lord Edward Perry) :

A&S meets weekly in Middlegate. Lord Edward would love to come to your arts and science gatherings, let him know when they will be. A/S is about to restart at every Thursday rapier practice.

New Business

Rapier practice: meeting location at the church in Claremont – for this indoor space this has been costing \$25 per night (rented once weekly) The price recently has DOUBLED and is now \$50/night The Exchequer has reviewed finances and has found we have gained approximately \$800 in total over the last 4 years. Looking at this and baronial accounts as a whole will help us decide if there is an expense we can continue to realistically make.

However, we have been hosting less events this last year or so than prior.

Advantage of this location is it is currently well attended and provides a meeting area in baronial lands that normally doesn't have much support (used to be the old location of Belfire Don Canton). Downside would be the location is further from the main barony center of the greater Charlotte Region.

Note from Exchequer.

As a non-profit – we are not able to spend money to benefit one person or one group of people. If they barony spends money this needs to be a space that is open to everyone.

As such do we want to continue this same location?

- Proposal would be \$300 in July and \$250 for August.
- 19 members in attendance. 17 approve. 2 abstain, 0 oppose
- Expense is approved

Children's Fete Funds

- The Children's Fete is held the Wednesday of War Week at Pennsic. The Kingdom of Atlantia hosts a half day event yearly for the children. This has activities like face-painting and Whack-a-Knight along with dress up as characters and snacks/drinks.
- The Barony of Sacred Stone has budgeted expense for this annually for the past several years but it was not added to the budget for this year and would need approval. Funds are used for supplies and food.
- Proposal is for \$300 to be allotted for the budget which should more than cover expenses. Receipts would be collected after purchase for an exact total for reimbursement.
- 15 members in attendance at this time. 14 approve, 1 abstain, 0 no
- Expense is approved
