Baronial Clerk Signet

The position involves: Working with the Baron and Baroness for scroll assignments / awards, working with the other scribes of the Barony for handling assignments, working with the MOAS for planning scroll competitions at events, and working with the Baronial Herald.

Minister of the Lists

Minister of the List is a position within the Marshal structure to organize and document tournaments, record fighter authorizations and report the results in an unbiased fashion.

A Minister of the List (MoL) helps organize, complete and maintain the paperwork needed to track fighters' authorizations and run combat scenarios at events. They are the people sitting at the table on the side of the list field signing in combatants, checking authorization cards, recording authorizations, and filling out all those lovely forms necessary to keep fighting in Atlantia running smoothly.

Deputy Exchequer

The exchequer serves as the group treasurer. Becoming a deputy is a good way to learn how the office works! Being deputy does NOT mean you are required to become exchequer of the barony in the future, so check it out!

Deputy Seneschal

A seneschal in the Society for Creative Anachronism is an administrative officer and the modern equivalent of a president or chief operating officer. Again, being deputy is a great way to learn how the office works, you are not required to step up to seneschal in the future if you are the deputy.

Letter from Their Excellencies

Cancellation of In a Phoenix Eye/Runestone Debrief

Dear populace,

It is with a heavy heart I announce the cancellation of Runestone / In a Phoenix Eye event which was scheduled for Nov 16th, 2024. During WOW, I was notified that our venue was no longer available for our event. Our Excellencies were notified of this cancellation

and we discussed how we should proceed and prevent this from occurring again.

Upon review of the bid, application, and execution of this event, several issues came to light. The first issue was in securing our location. In order to prevent the location being booked or found unavailable (in our case), follow-up is needed both during the contract negotiation step as well as after the contract is signed. I failed to follow-up with the venue in a timely manner and I did not get a signed contract. We are fortunate these oversights did not cost us any Baronial funds.

There are several Autocrat 101 guides that recommend looking at alternate locations should one fall through. My team and I did not look around the same area for alternate locations during our bidding process. Had we taken this step (with the above follow-up), it is possible an alternate location could have been secured and the event shifted accordingly.

How do I as an autocrat or event steward get better at the planning and execution of events? The best solution I know is to practice and mentor with experienced autocrats. To that end, I have reached out to several former autocrats to discuss serving on their staff as their deputy so I can gain more experience. It is my hope with

their guidance and the Barony's support, the In a Phoenix Eye / Runetone event model can be resurrected in the spring. I believe this event benefits the artists and scientists of our Barony by providing them the opportunity to show their work, research, or just be in community with each other.

Again, I cannot thank my staff enough for their support and flexibility. Should you have any additional questions, please don't hesitate to ask.

An event doesn't have to be a whole weekend 100+ person events, don't be afraid to have something small and new!

According to the calendar - Charlesbury Crossing has been busy with biweekly meetings - fighting and arts/science (fighting will be on hiatus for now due to the outdoor location and colder/darker weather), Greensboro has weekly arts/science meetings, Claremont in baronial lands has weekly rapier practice. Exchequer (Meisterin Jdeke von Kolberg) :

Includes info from 8-18-2024, since no meeting was held in September

Balance \$30,805.96

Nine checks were written since last report:

- To Bethel Lutheran Church for meeting space in September and October, \$350, per vote
- taken during August meeting
- To Head Troll for SSBB for gate seed money, \$200, returned 9/7/24
- To SCA Inc for NMR for SSBB, \$310
- To Nikole Harrington for feast expenses, \$679.65
- To Kevin Blake, refund for SSBB, \$15
- To Robin A. Leguillow, stamps for exchequer office, approved in August meeting, \$14.60
- To Tammy Reid, supplies for SSBB, \$144.34
- To Colin Bulla, table and chair rental for SSBB, \$500
- To Elchenburg Castle, Inc, SSBB site fee, \$2251 (\$2401 less deposit paid in May)

Deposits for income from SSBB, for Gate and pre-registration from checks and SCORES, totaled \$6413.86. Expenses totaled \$4324.99. This is a profit of \$1,169.87. The event report is complete. Due to a difference in the counts done at Gate, and the final counts done for the report, a revised NMR report must be submitted, and an additional \$30 sent to kingdom. The 3rd quarter report, due 10/31/24, was completed and submitted on 10/2/24. The approved financial policy was submitted to Kingdom on 10/12/2024. I haven't yet heard back on whether Kingdom approved it or not.

 - ii. Officer funds
 1. Proposal for \$50/year for each officer on base budget
 2. Request to increase MOAS to \$500 - for items such as supplies for workshop
 - iii. Weekly meeting
 1. Claremont site. \$50 per week, 52 weeks = \$2600
 - iv. Pennsic Fete fund
 1. Request is \$500. Prior costs were \$150-300
 - v. Baronial Storage Unit
 1. Cost yearly has been \$660, written for \$1000 for cushion

- a. This would be available for purchase by the Barony or by individuals
- b. Discussion occurred at this meeting

- i. We have previously discussed the desire for baronial/archery supplies at this site. These items could fill this need
- ii. If used only for baronial events - this could take years to recoup price (Last event cost \$500 for rental from Colin which was an undercut of typical rental price).
- iii. Typical rental of tables/chairs involves placement where you want the tablets/chairs. In this cause event staff may be responsible for movement of table/chairs to and from storage each time
- iv. Request from the populace - cost comparison for purchase/ vs rental - return of investment calculations.
 1. Mistress Jdeke has records of comparison to typical rental cost
 - a. Estimate of typical rental cost provided from an individual at meeting was around \$800
 2. Renting the tables/chairs to Kingdom could help offset cost
- v. Concerns of the long term viability of the Elchenburg site
- c. Care of this item would be under the purview of the exchequer/quartermaster
- d. Plan to have vote on this at a future meeting after more information and discussion
