Champion Challenges for Upcoming Baronial Birthday

Specialty	Baronial Champion Competition
Arts & Sciences	Rise from the Ashes: Part 1: a project that failed or you were unhappy with. Part 2: same project redone with lessons learned from Part 1. Write what you learned and what you changed
Bardic Arts	Perform two songs or stories. One must be pre-1650, the other may be filked or original creation by the performer.
Brewing Arts	Brew something with fruit other than grapes: fruit beers, ciders, and melomels. Write how you made it.
Armored Combat	Open tournament in round robin style. Each contest fought best of three. Top two warriors compete best two of three using two different weapons forms. Forms do not have to match.
Armored Warlord	Write a training proposal that involves warm ups, drills, melee communication, blow calibration, teamwork, and cool downs to use with Sacred Stone warriors at practices.

The Populace of Sacred Stone- our noble Excellencies and our great Seneschal Master Patris need your aid! The barony is currently in need of:

Baronial Clerk Signet

The position involves: Working with the Baron and Baroness for scroll assignments / awards, working with the other scribes of the Barony for handling assignments, working with the MOAS for planning scroll competitions at events, and working with the Baronial Herald.

Minister of the Lists (or deputy)

Minister of the List is a position within the Marshal structure to organize and document tournaments, record fighter authorizations and report the results in an unbiased fashion.

A Minister of the List (MoL) helps organize, complete and maintain the paperwork needed to track fighters' authorizations and run combat scenarios at events. They are the people sitting at the table on the side of the list field signing in combatants, checking authorization cards, recording authorizations, and filling out all those lovely forms necessary to keep fighting in Atlantia running smoothly.

Deputy Exchequer

The exchequer serves as the group treasurer. Becoming a deputy is a good way to learn how the office works! Being deputy does NOT mean you are required to become exchequer of the barony in the future, so check it out!

Deputy Seneschal

A seneschal in the Society for Creative Anachronism is an administrative officer and the modern equivalent of a president or chief operating officer. Again, being deputy is a great way to learn how the office works, you are not required to step up to seneschal in the future if you are the deputy.

- Two checks were written since last report:
 - To Bethel Lutheran Church for meeting space in August, \$150
 - To SCA Inc, for insurance for Baronial Birthday, \$75
- 20 yards of trim were sold, total income \$20
- 46 yards of trim were provided for use at SSBB, no charge (Baronial event, Barony owns trim, no need to "sell" it to the event)
- There was financial committee vote to allow for 'comped' attendance for SSBB for visiting royals from other Kingdoms
- 1 pre-registration by check has been received for SSBB
- I am looking for deputies not necessarily to take over as exchequer at any point if they don't like, but to learn how the job works and more about the position

Canton of Middlegate has improved its finances and signature card has been updated in proper standing.

Salesberie Glen:

Fighter practice/ general meetup (all are welcome!) at Kelsey Scott park on Thursdays at 6pm

We are looking to set up an event - St. Irmo's on March 15th!

Crois Brigte: in the process of dissolution - Kingdom has received our official intent to dissolve, no further information to report

Old Business

- Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday September 6-8 at Elchenburg
 - Staff meeting for SSBB will follow baronial meeting
 - From Mistress Aine, the autocrat. There are 88 registrations for the event and 25 registrations for the feast. Classically this event has had more walk-ins at gate vs pre-reg. Planning several hundred attendees at this point. There may be 400 people. We MAY need to have another financial vote in case we think there

will be additional attendance that requires additional toilets or trash purposes. If necessary this could require an emergency financial vote if needed

- 0 Good Afternoon Sacred Stone, My apologies for not joining you today but as many know – I have a heck of a drive to get there and back. I would like to submit my report for the Reservations and Gate Prep for our Sacred Stone Baronial Birthday "the Phoenix and the Dragon." The numbers as of 8/18/24 at 1:30 pm are: 85 plus 3 comps currently Feast is currently at 35 SCORES will close on 9/3/24 at 11:59 pm I would like to remind all members that SSBB, after manning this event over the past 5+ years, that this is a heavy Gate registration event to the point of over 300 last year. I expect quite a few walk ins for the event. Gate will formally be open on Friday at 3:00 pm to Gate Staff, and close at 2:00 pm on Saturday. As far as needs: Gate will only require (2) 6ft Tables and one 75-100' Extension Cord all other items will be coming with me including Table Covers, Baskets for the Site Tokens, etc. The underage Blue Wrist Bands and Children Bands will be in place. Waivers, SCORES and Clipboards are provided in my kit. My only recommendation is for a basic hand out: 8x10 cut in half with the schedule on the front and a map on the back to eliminate consistent questioning asked by those Gating in. In your service, Mistress Adair of Makyswell Gate Minister
- Mistress Aine will be there all day Friday if you are available please feel free to come early to help with set up! Pavilions etc needs to be set up. His Excellency will be there starting in the morning to help to set up.
- There will be two peerage vigils on Friday night, and there will be another peerage as well. These can need help with setup.
 - Also prepare that court is likely to be long
- If you are able/willing to volunteer or are able to help out, assistance is always wanted and appreciated!
- In a Phoenix Eye/ Runestone : November 16th.
 - Collegium and arts/science event. This is a blended event. This is the showcase
 of projects for members of the barony (think like an art gallery). Combined with
 a teaching event. This event is up against a lot of other events on the Kingdom
 calendar (5 events this weekend). Don't let this scare you as pre-COVID this was
 normal to see multiple events with different focus. This also has air conditioning
 and is indoors!

- Website has launched. Registration/signup is not active yet but it is starting to come online
- Plan for feast: After close of classes the feast will be heavy hors d'oeuvres you can eat while socializing/dancing, so it will not be a sit-down feast.
 - We are also seeking people to help with feast prep. Please reach out to Mistress Anora and she will get you connected.
- We are seeking teachers! Prefer to have teachers planned by October to make sure we set up the space/schedule
- Their Excellencies will be teaching a class (for all that have even a passing interest) in how to be landed baronage in Atlantia. You can also ask us questions about it at any time outside of this class as well.
- Fencing (and archery!) Practice in Claremont at Bethel Lutheran Church in Claremont NC
 - Archery now available outside at this location! Had the first archery practice last week
 - Attendance is 10-16 people each practice and attendance is growing. 9 fencers are local to Sacred Stone, and not borrowed from Hawkwood!
 - Costs \$50/night. August is paid for
 - Looked for a cheaper venue but others in the area are more expensive (\$50 per hour vs \$50 per day). This location is also of good quality, can expand to fit needs, and is just off the highway
 - We are still looking for alternative/cheaper sites
 - This site allows fighting including rapier (and heavy) practice indoors and outdoors based on the weather. It also has chairs/tables for art projects and modern plumbing. It also allows archery outside
 - VOTE: asking \$350 to pay for the site through October (skipping Halloween)
 18 in favor, 1 abstain, 0 against
- Sacred Stone Cooks Guild
 - Plans to keep active as an information source keep the FB page open and such, but there was not enough of a response/interest to have administrative attention to have it stay as an active guild at this time.
 - There are some cooks guild items in different places, can be combined if needed.

- Autumn Jubilee Demo same weekend as Coronation October 5th 6th. Plan arts/science primarily for Saturday and fighting for Sunday. This is a Dan Nicols park in Salisbury.
- Canva subscription for making newsletters this can make a much nicer presentation service. It's \$120 per person per year.
 - Other baronies use this service or Adobe Pro
 - Mistress Aine will also check into what her shop uses
 - This is also used to do a lot of other social media presence and other online coordination
 - Proposal: one account one year trial for the Barony of Sacred Stone
 - 16 in approval, 3 abstain, 0 against

New Business

- Exchequer needs to purchase stamps
 - Proposal for \$20 budget allotment
 - approval 18, abstain 1, oppose 0
- Children's Fete snacks for Pennsic in 2025 Anora and Robert have been organizing for years and would like others to be in charge going forward. We would be available to help teach and provide guidance on how to do this job.
