One of our favourite things at Pennsic is the Known World Baronial Champions

Tournament, in large part because it is *not* about who wins a fight. You see, any of
the Baronage in attendance may participate, and any Champion may enter
(several participants are champion-for-the-day, accounting for
baronage/champion availability at War). There is no list; all of the assembled
Champions are encouraged to go forth and fight as many of the other assembled
Champions as possible. While these personal combats are taking place, candidates
are called to present themselves to the assembled Baronage, and answer questions.

The first three questions are (usually) the same, after which the floor is opened for any Coronet to ask what they will, before the next candidate is called forth. Honestly, it has the feel of a very active fighter practice, with an ongoing Baronial court. It's great fun, we get to meet baronage from across the Known World, and the candidates range from fairly new to heavy fighting, through knights. The field is delightfully polite, the fighting is much more friendly and instructive, rather than competitive, and the individual responses are considerate and humble. This past Pennsic, when we (the baronage) assembled to choose our victor, one thing had struck most of us. When asked, "What is the best part of representing your Barony?", the most prevalent answer was, in essence, "The sense of belonging and family." Almost to a fault. The words varied, the presentation wavered occasionally, but the message was, with few exceptions, unity. To hear this, not from Sacred Stone's champion (we did not have one in this tournament) but from around the Known World is, indeed, humbling, and we can happily report the assembled baronage took notice.

Many of you have seen us, during setup or teardown, in shirts reading, "SCA Chosen Family". It is not just a morale booster or feel-good thing, we very much feel you are our chosen family, and occasions like the one stated above only bolster that. We, your Baronage, met in this organization, and count the majority of our most meaningful relationships within it. While it is a tremendous joy to celebrate those relationships at every event, life seems to balance great joy with great sorrow. Indeed, grief is coming to terms with the loss of happiness; the more substantial the happiness, equally so the grief. While each event brings connection and cheerfulness, it also brings the memory of those whose absence we mourn. There is not a war which does not set aside time to remember a list of those no longer around the fire. There is not an event where someone does not quietly remember their own list. We do not raise a glass, publicly or privately, without a nod to absent friends. Some of these losses go back decades, others are still new and raw, and sometimes all of them are hard to face, in equal measure. With this said, we humbly beg two boons. First, be kind and patient with each other. Atlantia has borne profound losses recently, and many in her populace are going to find memories in unexpected places at events. There is little more honorable than supporting someone in their grief, even when it means nothing more than standing patiently by their side.

Second, take some time to consider who you would mourn, should they suddenly exit from your company, and let them know they are important. While this is certainly implied in many cases (significant others, etc.), it costs nothing to tell someone they are important to you.

Finally, and most sincerely, know that each and every person reading these words is important to us. Really. Sacred Stone is filled with such an amazing, diverse, and talented group of people, and every one of you brings something to help make it awesome, and we recognize the light you add to the shine of our Barony. All of you, keep shining.


