#### Officer Reports

#### Seneschal (Master Patris de Terra Lepori) :

I will be stepping down after SSBB - in a few weeks. The Barony will be selecting a replacement Seneschal. We have received 2 letters of intent.

#### Exchequer (Meisterin Jdeke von Kolberg):

Exchequer Report, Baronial Meeting 17 August 2025

Balance \$30,483.96

The last Baronial Meeting was June 22 nd.

Seven checks were written since last report, for a total of \$4995.81:

- To Bethel Lutheran Church for meeting space for July August, \$400.00 per annual budget
- 2. To Optimist Club of Raleigh, site fee for SSBB prepaid in full, \$2100.00 per event budget
- 3. To John P. Brice, reimbursement for prepayment for porta johns for SSBB paid in full, \$1861.86 per event budget
- 4. To Kingdom of Atlantia, NMR for RAT 2025, \$130.00, in and out by attendees (gets sent to SCA)
- 5. To James Smith, refund for RAT 2025, \$25.00, did not attend after pre-paying
- To Bethel Lutheran Church for meeting space for September-October, \$350.00 per annual budget, reduced amount because we had one or more meetings cancelled due to weather in July or August
- 7. To Kathy Alma, reimbursement for supplies for Pennsic Children's Fete, \$128.95, per annual budget

One deposit was made since last report:

1. From various persons via SCORES for pre-registration for RAT 2025: \$ 2216.38

The event report for RAT 2025 is complete.

The quarterly exchequer report for Q2 was completed and submitted on time.

A meeting of the emergency financial committee was convened to vote on the budget of SSBB, revised due to the required move of the event from the Elchenburg site. The budget increased by \$662 for a move of the event to Optimist Farm. The EFC approved the revised budget.

I will be stepping down as Exchequer on 1/31/2026. We will begin accepting letters of intent on 10/31/2025, and the period for submitting such letters will continue until 12/31/2025, at which point the candidates will be announced to the Barony for a period of commentary and advice until 1/15/2026. Anyone who has questions about the job and responsibilities is

I encourage people who think they might be interested but are feeling uncertain of either their interest or their ability, to become deputies. This gives them a chance to observe the Exchequer processes and receive training, without committing them to becoming an active Exchequer. I am happy to host and train such deputies, and I'm sure my successor will also be happy.
