They are the people sitting at the table on the side of the list field signing in combatants, checking authorization cards, recording authorizations, and filling out all those lovely forms necessary to keep fighting in Atlantia running smoothly.

Two checks were written since last report:

To Olympic Crown Storage, to cover 1 year rental of our storage unit at \$55/month:

\$660. Per annual budget.

To Bethel Lutheran Church, to cover meeting space for March and April, \$400, per annual budget.

I went to Truist Bank on February 18 th and successfully closed the correct account for Crois Brigte. The bank kindly waived the fee for a second cashier's check. The balance of \$2708.37 was deposited to the SS account to hold in trust for Crois Brigte through December 2025. Lord Edward Perry will become Deputy Exchequer for Sacred Stone as soon as his warrant is signed by Their Majesties. I will begin training him with the next quarterly report – he has been an Exchequer but not for a group as active as Sacred Stone is. Anyone else who may be interested in being an Exchequer is welcome to join in that training.

- His excellency spoke to site owner and consensus is that it's probably better to demolish the structure and then potentially replace and if replaced – where

would it be placed?

- o now plan is for the shed to be purchased by the household House Grey for which there may be a fundraiser, for the purpose of holding archery supplies
